If your child will be five (5) years of age by August 1, 2022 and you plan to enroll him/her in Kindergarten, **PLEASE COMPLETE THE FORM BELOW AND RETURN IT TO VANLUE SCHOOL** <u>NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY, MARCH 8,</u> <u>2023.</u> Screening will be here at Vanlue on **Wednesday, March 15, 2023**. Please register your child <u>as soon as</u> <u>possible</u>. March 15 is the only day we will hold kindergarten screening for the 2023-2024 school year. Screening information and details will be mailed to those who register. A residential parent **MUST** accompany the child to the screening. An <u>original</u> birth certificate, shot records, social security card, and any custody papers need to be brought to the screening. 
