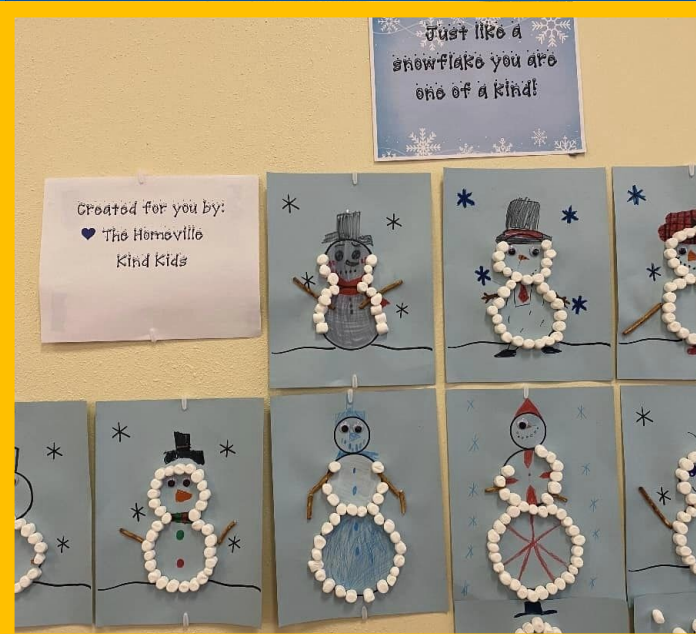

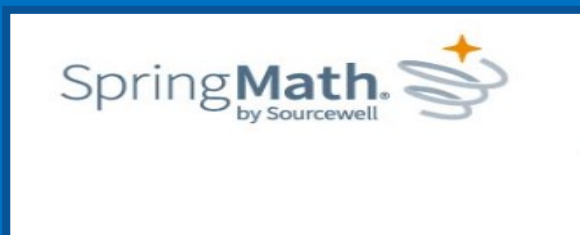

Mrs. Rader's class is making fantastic progress! The class is progressing at 1.3 weeks per skill.

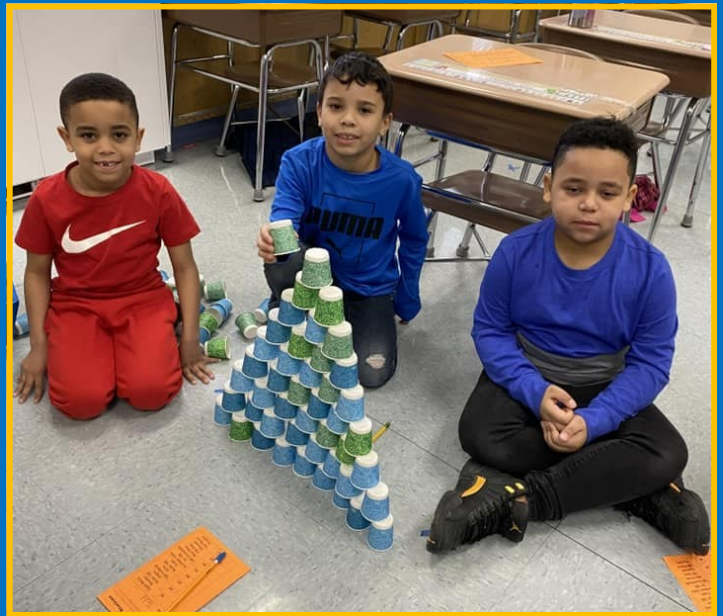
Mrs. Rader has been entering progress monitoring scores for all of the students and has excellent intervention consistency.

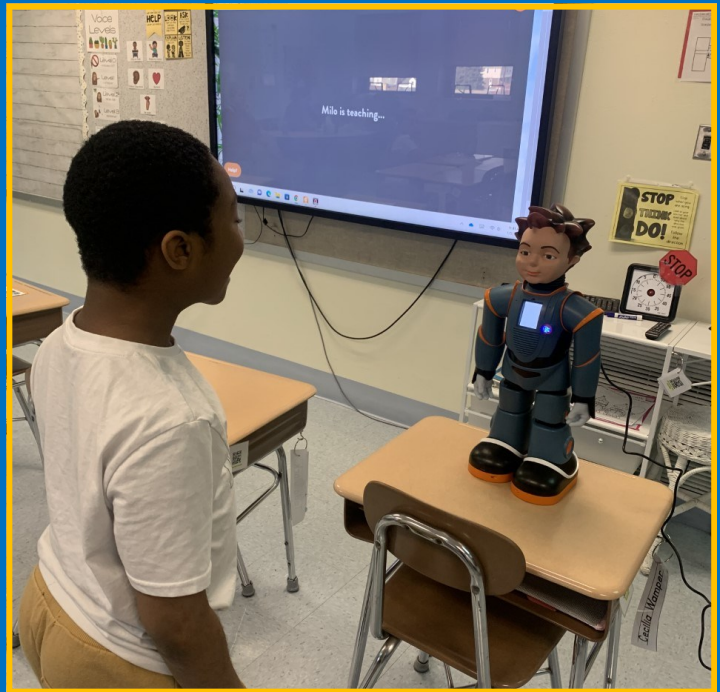
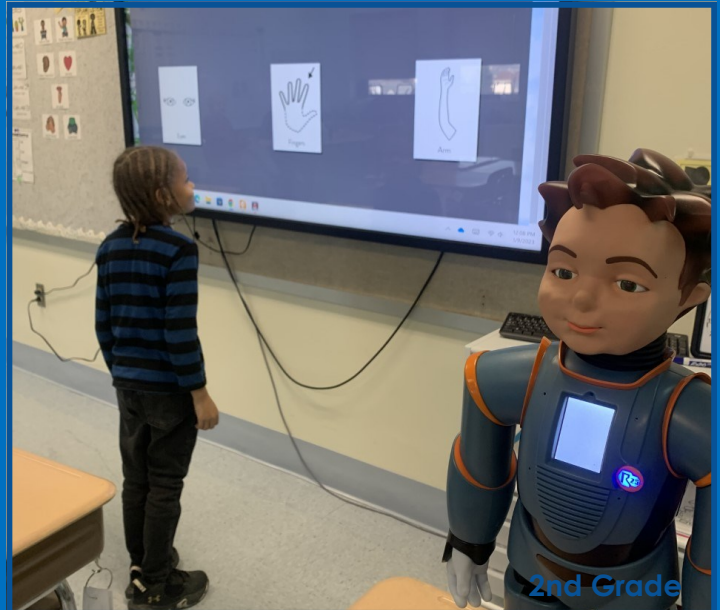
