SCHOOL YEAR 2025 - 2026 UPDATE

NEWCOMB MIDDLE SCHOOL SEVENTH & EIGHTH GRADES

As we navigate our way toward the future, change is inevitable, and change will hit Newcomb Middle School beginning School Year 2025 - 2026. A drastic and steady decline in student enrollment in the past couple of years and projections into our near future have highlighted challenges to our current structure. Beginning school year 2025-2026 all sixth graders, will remain at their designated elementary schools becoming Kindergarten to Sixth Grade. Newcomb Middle School will be a Seventh & Eighth grade school. This change will subtract from our current student population even more and changes have to be made to accommodate the lower numbers in student enrollment. These changes will be noticeable when school resumes on Wednesday, August 6, 2025 for school year 2025-2026.



STATE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS



April is student testing season in our great state of New Mexico and our students are scheduled to take these assessments beginning with our Eighth Graders who will take the New Mexico Assessment of Science Readiness on Wednesday, April 16, 2025. All students are scheduled to take the New Mexico Measures of Student Success & Achievement (NM-MSSA) on Tuesday, April 22 & 23, 2025. The NM-MSSA is New Mexico's summative assessment for Mathematics and English Language Arts. It is imperative that ALL STUDENTS attend school on these important dates as we have a short window for Make-Up testing. Please make sure your child comes to school well rested and ready to take the test when it is scheduled.




