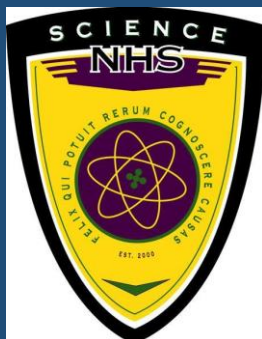

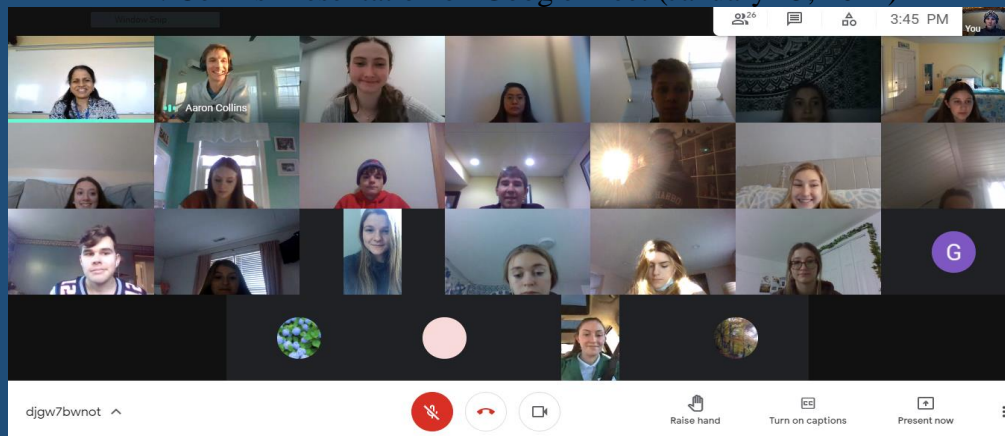
Our Mission:

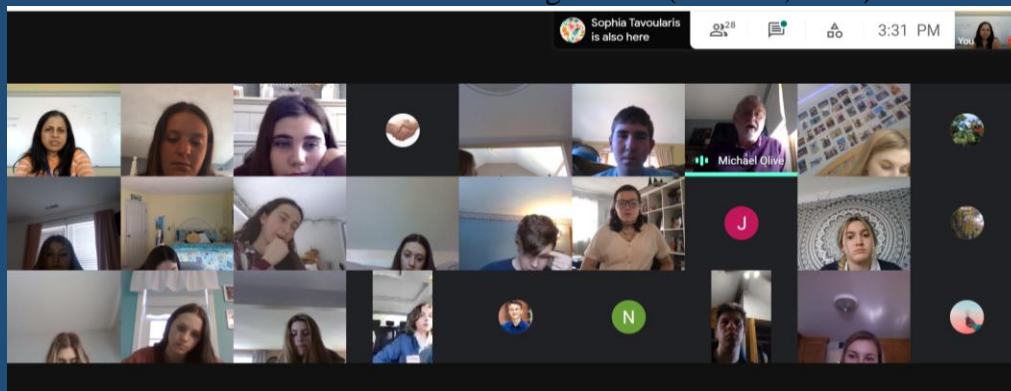
This year, SNHS invited two distinguished guest speakers to present to the society about various topics in their field:

Members of the society also created presentations on unique scientific topics of their interest and shared them with the rest of the members.

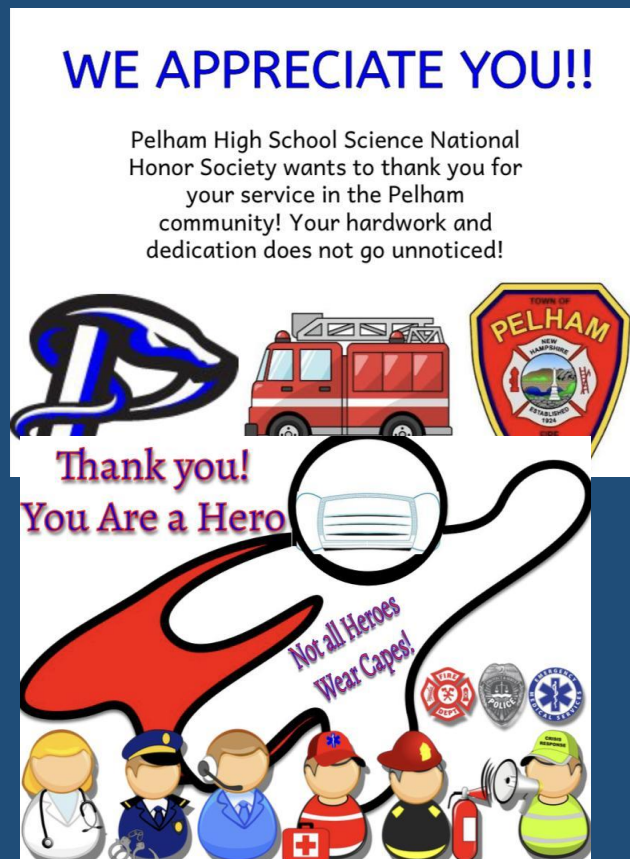
