Daylight Savings Time - Sunday, November 7th



Daylight Saving Time can wreak more havoc than one might think. When we look at the impact on student learning that the movement of just one hour makes, it is rather astounding. The loss of sleep while our bodies adjust can lead to trouble with focusing and learning. The great news is that there are some tried and true tips on combating the effects of DST. Practicing good sleep habits by establishing a consistent sleep routine and gradually altering your bedtime by 15 minutes or so two to three days prior to the change should help. Spending some time outside in natural sunlight can also help alleviate feelings of tiredness that often accompanies the time change.

Apprenticeship Opportunities: The NH Association of Insurance Agents (NHAIA) is about to launch a registered apprenticeship for the General Insurance Associate occupation. NHAIA, the apprenticeship sponsor, will work with insurance employers throughout the state who are interested in establishing an apprenticeship. We look forward to developing pre-apprenticeship agreements with interested high schools as well. Here are the details:
