These winners were recognized at the Claymont Foundation Awards Banquet on Saturday, May 12th.

Alumni award winners for 2018 are: Distinguished Alumnus Award - Mel Peters, Citizen of the Year Award - Barbara Huff Bollon, Alumnus of the Year Award - Jim Riley, Alumnus Achievement Award - Jason Johnson, and Teacher of the Year Award - Chett Peters.



Mel Peters, Uhrichsville Class of 1960, retired as a teacher and coach from Claymont City Schools in 1997. He taught Physical Education and served as the head coach for football, track and Wrestling. He is a graduate of Ohio Northern University.

When he retired from coaching, he began announcing football and wrestling on WBTC radio. In March, he officially retired from the broadcasting business as well. Mel owned Eagle Nest Western Shop for 20 years and is the owner of Mel Peter's Tire and Auto since 1999.

His recognitions include: ONU Hall of Fame; Life Member of ONU Alumni N Men; National Wrestling Hall of Fame; 1972 Outstanding Young Man of America; 2006 Media Service Award and 1992 Twin City Chamber of Commerce Distinguished Award Winner.

Mel Peters is a member of Immaculate Conception Church, Moose, K of C and AIC. Mel Peters and his wife Theresa live in Uhrichsville. They have eight sons, Scott, Matt, Brett, Chett, Kurtt, Rhett, Elliott and Clintt and one daughter, Brittney as well as 28 grandchildren and two great grandchildren.



Jim Riley, a 1993 Claymont graduate, is the Director of Marketing for the Columbus Blue Jackets. He oversees all aspects of the organization's marketing efforts including advertising, branding, ticket promotions, signage, community events and creative services.

Riley joined the Blue Jackets organization during the 2007-08 season as Marketing Manager for Nationwide Arena events and the Columbus Destroyers of the Arena Football League.
