We are excited to announce that due to a new waiver extension given by the USDA we are able to provide meals (breakfast and lunch) at no cost to all students until the current waiver expires.

We want to share our plan for Grab and Go Breakfast/Lunch Meals in the Classroom (MIC) and Remote Meal Pick up for the 2020-2021 school year at the Pelham School District. Our goal for MIC in Pelham is to ensure that the Pelham School District safely opens in the fall of 2020. In order to achieve our district goal we have made the following plans in conjunction with our district administration and local health authorities.

Preordering for Meals and Menus: Families, students and/or staff must pre-order meals (breakfast and lunch) using the system available at https://pelhamsd.nutrislice.com/menu/menus-eula. Meals can be pre-ordered up to 5 school days ahead of time.

Remote Pick Up Meals and Menus: ALL REMOTE LEARNER MEALS WILL BE PICKED UP AT PES. Remote meal pick-up will be provided and must be pre-ordered at https://pelhamsd.nutrislice.com/menu/menus-eula. Meals are at no cost until further notice. When the USDA meal waiver runs out those who have a free or reduced application on file will remain benefit eligible for the Free and Reduced Meal Program.
