The Big Vision:

To empower families to help their young children (0-5) learn by turning everyday moments like waiting at a bus stop or grocery shopping into playful learning moments that promote connection between caregivers and young children and ultimately fosters the healthy brain development young children need to enter kindergarten ready to learn.

What is Play on Purpose?

An initiative of Learn to Earn Dayton, led by a planning committee of over 35 partnering organizations, to blanket the City of Dayton/Montgomery County with evidence-based playful prompts and learning experiences ("POP Spots!") in community spaces.

This is innovative placemaking intended to bring play and learning opportunities into everyday moments and into the neighborhoods and community spaces where our most underserved families are.













Mosaics are going up all around Montgomery County that have early childhood games embedded into them!
