### **Advancing Equity Position Statement**

- 1. Early childhood educators have an obligation to provide the equitable, strength-based learning opportunities ALL children deserve
- 2. All early childhood educators must have equitable access to those supports that enable them to assume their roles as professional educators (higher education, professional development and increased compensation)

#### **Different Questions Asked**

Diversity – Who is in the room?

 Inclusion – Has everyone's ideas been heard?

 Diversity – How many more of (pick minoritized group) do we have this year than last?

- Equity Whose presence in the room is under constant threat of erasure?
- Justice Whose ideas won't be taken seriously because they aren't in the majority?
- Equity What conditions have we created that maintain certain groups as the perpetual majority here?

#### **Different Questions Asked**

- Inclusion Is this environment safe for everyone to feel like they belong?
- Diversity Celebrates increased numbers that still reflect minoritized status and incremental growth
