1. Attend an Info Night

Information Nights are held between October and February. For more information on when and where these will be held, please contact your school counselor.



2. Submit a Letter of Intent

For public school students submit your letter to your school counselor. Non-public or Homeschooled students submit letters to the Ohio Department of Higher Education. The deadline for submission is April 1, 2021.



3. Apply to Columbus State

Complete the free College Credit Plus application at cscs.edu/apply. You will receive your CougarID and Acceptance letter via email in 2-3 business days after submitting your application. Check your junk/spam folders and add Columbus State as a safe sender.



4. Submit Test Scores/Placement Testing

Talk to your school counselor about available placement testing options. Visit: www.cscs.edu/admissions/placement-testing/college-credit-plus.shtml for the latest information.



5. Turn in Consent Form/Orientation

Turn in your completed College Credit Plus consent form to **CCPadvising@cscs.edu** prior to registering for courses. Only one CCP consent form is required per academic year. The form can be found on the cscs.edu website by searching: College Credit Plus forms. You'll also take the online CCP orientation.



6. Register for Classes!
