CONSENT AGENDA

- The Board of Education approved the retirement of MHS math teacher Julie Bell effective at the end of the 2024-25 school year. It also approved additional duties for Jeff Radloff (Friday School), Nick Leone (event supervisor and cheer competition), Joe Veeneman (event supervisor) and Jane Smith (swim meet computer operator) and hours/days adjustments for Emily James (10 extra days), Sarah Davis (after School enrichment, up to 80 hours of teaching) and Lisa Good (after school enrichment, up to 30 hours of teaching).
- College credit approvals/reimbursements were approved for Maria Childs (3 credits), Kristen Keyes (8 credits), Colleen Herking (3 credits) and Courtney Miller (3 credits).

ACTION AGENDA

- The Board approved the school calendars for both the 2025-26 and 2026-27 school years. Superintendent Estopp shared that a lot of consideration goes into the creation of school calendars, including feedback from the administrative team, staff council and superintendent's advisory group. FINANCIAL REPORT

- Treasurer/CFO Tom Golinar reviewed the financial report and investments for the month of October, which is a third of the way through the fiscal year. He shared that the reports are on track per the forecast.
- As he does each November, Mr. Golinar also shared the updated five-year forecast, which shows additional levy dollars, increasing funding by \$3.1 million per year.
- The Board approved the Food Service Report-Nutritional Standards, which is enforced by state law.
- Mr. Golinar also announced that there will be a IDEA/ESEA Hearing on December 9, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at Mariemont High School.
