MEETING RECAP

JANUARY | 2026

- At the opening of the meeting, returning Board members Andi Murphy and Dave Rogers, along with new Board member Brad Dewey, took the oath of office. Elections were held for the open president and vice president positions where Andi Murphy was selected as the Board of Education president and Nan Dill was selected as the vice president for the 2026 calendar year.

ORGANIZATIONAL AGENDA

- The Board also approved several annual items, including the superintendent's authorization to approve attendance at professional meetings and accept resignations and hire staff between Board meetings; the treasurer's authorization to make appropriations adjustments, invest, and enter into/or accept/or participate in Federal, State and Local grants; appointments of liaisons for various groups; appointment of general legal advisor; etc.

CONSENT AGENDA

- The Board of Education approved the resignation of Hailey Rothert (ME, instructional aide).

- Treasurer/CFO Tom Golinar reviewed the financial report and investments for the month of December, which is halfway through the fiscal year. He shared that the reports are on track per the forecast and he will have an updated five-year-forecast at the February Board of Education meeting.
- Mr. Golinar also announced the adopted tax budget, which is something the district does each January.
