## CONSENT AGENDA

- The employment of MJHS Spanish teacher Madelyn Blankenship was approved by the Board.
- The Board of Education accepted the resignation of MJHS Spanish teacher Lindsay Elzey.
- The Board also approved the hours/days adjustments for Tasha Alderman.
- College credit pre-approvals and reimbursements were approved for Amanda Loy and Lauren Witte.
- Strategic compensation payments for staff were approved.

## ACTION AGENDA

- The Board approved the Blizzard Bag resolution for the 2022-23 school year. The state has reinstated its rule that allows districts to adopt a resolution for Blizzard Bags (online learning) for each school year in the event of snow days or other calamity days which may temporarily close school buildings. The district typically only considers the use of Blizzard Bags (online learning) after exhausting five calamity days.

## FINANCIAL REPORT

- Treasurer/CFO Tom Golinar reviewed the financial report and announced that all district finances are on track per the forecast. General Fund expenditures for FY22 increased by only 0.4%, mainly due to the availability and use of COVID-related federal funds.
- The Board approved the renewal of the contract with food services provider Aramark. There was an overall increase to the contract of about 3% which is mostly due to inflation. The usual cost or savings to the district fluctuates each year based on the number of meals sold and federal reimbursements.
