ROUTINES

- The Board of Education motioned to add an executive session to discuss the employment of a public official.

CONSENT AGENDA

- The BOE approved the employment of Paige Francis (ME counselor); Nick Carlson (MJHS social studies teacher); Debbie Howard (MHS intervention specialist); Amanda Loy (TPE kindergarten teacher); Sarah Conkle (TPE teacher); Aaron Pfeffenberger (MJHS Principal); Bryan Barthelmas (Registered Behavioral Technician); and Xander Stigall (summer tech help).
- The Board approved the resignations of Leigh Sullivan (special education aide); Kathy Lynch (special education aide); Aaron Pfeffenberger (ME Dean of Students); and Rob Polca (MJHS Principal).
- Transfers were approved for Emily James (K-12 literacy support specialist); and Lindsey Wise (ME sixth grade teacher).
- The Board approved changes in hours/days for Emily James (10 extra days); Lindsay Oberschlake (5 extra days); and Paige Francis (10 extra days).
- The Board also approved payments for strategic compensation and for extended school year (ESY teachers).

ACTION AGENDA

- The Board approved a settlement agreement and release with the SpringHill Condo Association.
- The BOE also approved a resolution to adopt a calamity day makeup plan, an annual requirement for the state of Ohio that details a plan for continued education should the district exceed five calamity days in a school year.
