• The Board approved updates to 41 school district policies after having a first reading for these policy adjustments during the November Board of Education meeting.

FINANCIAL REPORT

- Treasurer/CFO Tom Golinar reviewed the financial report and investments for the month of November and announced that all district finances are on track per the forecast.
- Mr. Golinar announced the upcoming Board of Education meeting on January 8, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at Mariemont High School. Nan Dill was voted to act as the Board president to open the organizational meeting.

REPORTS/INFORMATION/COMMUNICATION/DISCUSSION

- Director of Teaching and Learning, Shannon Kromer, gave an update on the district's literacy instruction with some new guidelines from the state being implemented in the new year. The district created a new literacy webpage, which you can view here.
- Director of Student Services, Tricia Buchert, gave an update on the Save Act and Erin's Law. Both
 are components to House Bill 123. The SAVE (Safety And Violence Education) Act deals with school
 security and youth suicide awareness education and training. Erin's Law requires schools to provide
 age-appropriate sexual abuse prevention education to students, train school personnel on child sexual
 abuse detection and warn parents and guardians of child sexual abuse warning signs.
