FEBRUARY | 2026

- The regular Board of Education meeting in February followed the Board's annual February work session. During this work session, the Board heard from members of the administrative team about the progress of the Destination NEXT strategic plan, set to launch in August 2026. The Board provided its feedback to guide the direction as the plan continues to take shape.

## CONSENT AGENDA

- The Board of Education approved the retirement of ME teacher Amy Uhl, who will be re-hired for the 2026-27 school year. It also approved hours/days adjustments for ticket workers Paige Strickland, Betsy Ecker, Kelli Radloff and Kim Arp, and accepted the resignation (effective Feb. 9) and re-employment (effective Feb. 11) of John Parker, supervisor of buildings and grounds.

- College credit pre-approval requests and reimbursements were approved for Jennifer Niezgoda (TPE, 6 credits) and Ashley Toon (TPE, 3 credits).
