PUBLIC HEARING FOR RETIRE/REHIRE

- The Board of Education held a public hearing for two Mariemont High School staff members who plan to retire/rehire for the 2025-26 school year, Jeff Radloff and Steve Phelps.

CONSENT AGENDA

- As we continue through hiring season, the Board of Education approved the employment of five staff members for the 2025-26 school year, including Brandon Finke (success center coach); Robert Elbrecht (sub custodian); Mogan Elash (ME, kindergarten teacher); Aimee Devine (MHS, broadcast journalism teacher); Megan Geary (MHS, counselor). It also accepted resignations from Joe Regruth (head baseball coach); Brandon Finke (special education aide); Sophia Domenick (academic support aide); Mary Tensing (ME, special education aide); Chelsea Myers (MHS, counselor); Jessica Bush (ME, 5th grade teacher); Lindsey Wise (ME, 6th grade teacher). Additionally, hours/days adjustments were approved for Christian Compton (ESY services); Bryan Barthelmas, Janine Cutcher and Anna Goeke (RBT training); Brandon Finke (3 extra days); Kim Arp, Paola Biro, Natalie Lynch and Tricia Woitha (Ohio Partnership for Excellence in Paraprofessional Preparation district leadership team); Shannon Kromer (director of teaching and learning, 42 extended days); Colleen Herking (gifted intervention specialist/gifted coordinator, 20 extended days); Megan Geary (MHS counselor, 20 extra days). And Shannon Kromer was placed on a certificated salary schedule at level M32 for the 2025-26 school year.
