CONSENT AGENDA

- The Board of Education accepted the retirement of MHS math and computer science teacher Bruce Miller effective at the end of the school year.
- The employment of a volunteer assistant boys lacrosse coach and orchestra musician were approved by the Board as well as a college credit reimbursement for Maria Childs.

ACTION AGENDA

- The Board passed a resolution allowing for a paper and pencil version of the Grade 3 Ohio State Test in English Language Arts. Superintendent Estep reported that the default version of this test is online, however kids in this grade tend to perform better with a paper and pencil test. The district will return to this paper/pencil version during the 2022-23 school year.
- The Board approved a student trip to the DECA International Career Development Conference April 23-27 in Atlanta, Georgia. Around 10 MHS students advanced from the state DECA conference and will participate in this next level of competition.

FINANCIAL REPORT

- Treasurer/CFO Tom Golinar reviewed the financial report and announced that all district finances are on track for the forecast.
- Mr. Golinar also reported that the regular Board of Education meeting in June will now be held on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 7 p.m. in the Mariemont Elementary cafeteria.
