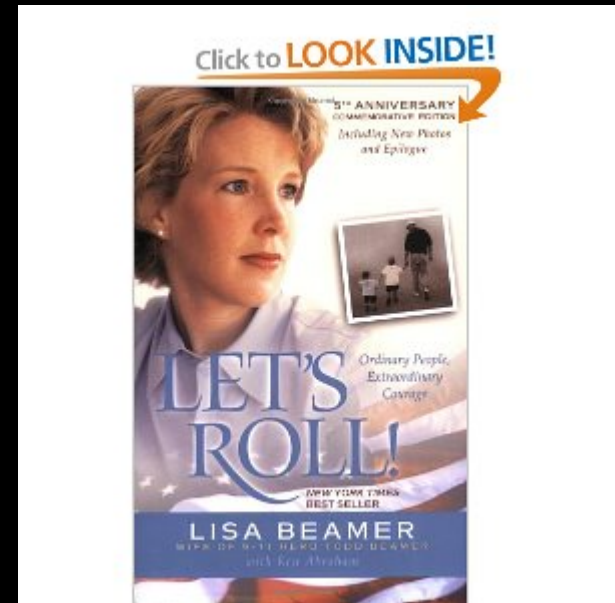


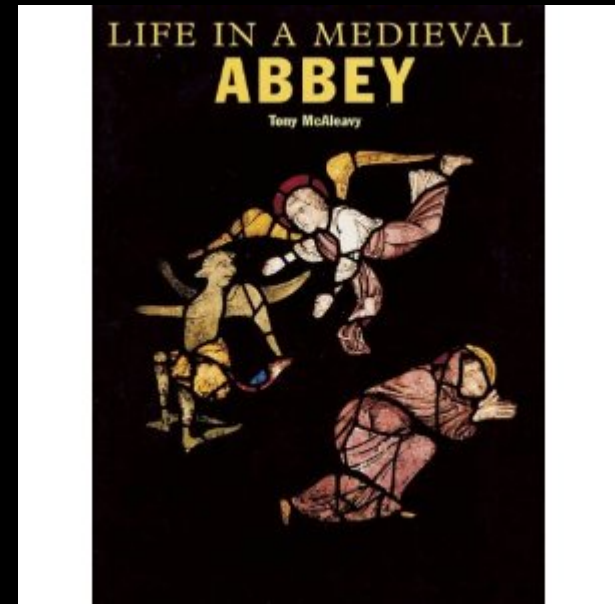
LET'S ROLL

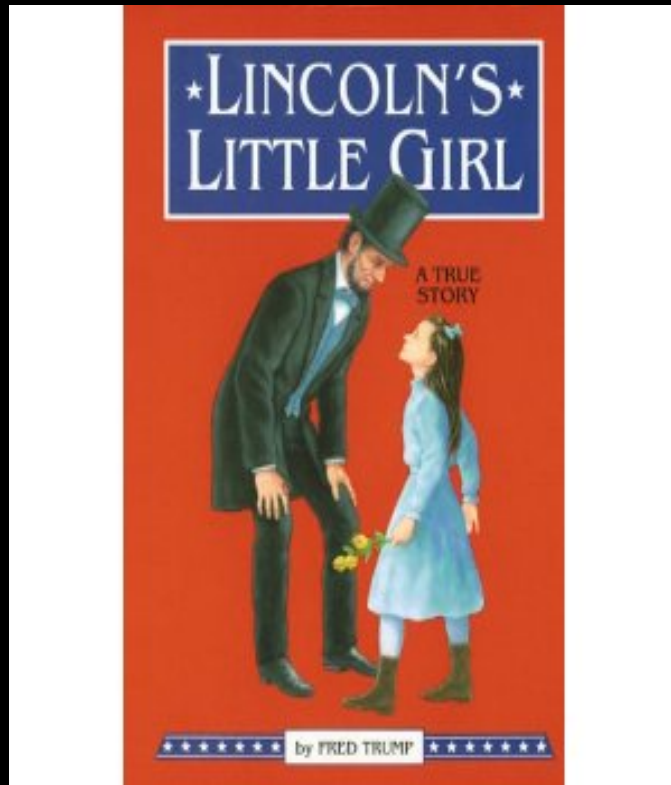


LIFE IN A MEDIEVAL ABBEY

- In this book, discover what kind of people lived in abbeys, their daily routine, their great achievements, and why they finally disappeared.



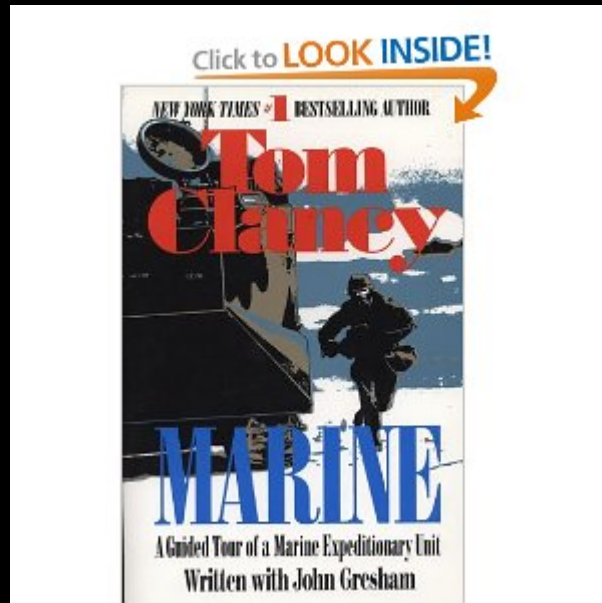

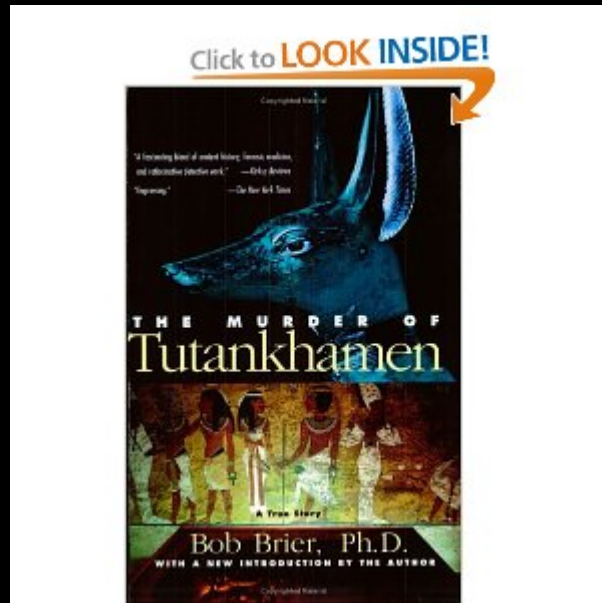
- This is a biography of Grace Bedell, who as a young girl wrote to Abraham Lincoln suggesting he grow whiskers.

- Tom Clancy takes you on a fascinating detailed tour of the United States Marine Corps -- the training, the technology, and the people.



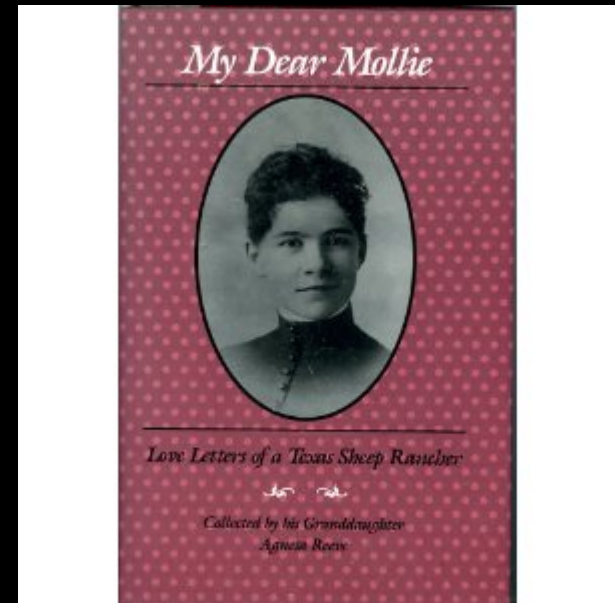
MURDER OF TUTANKHAMEN

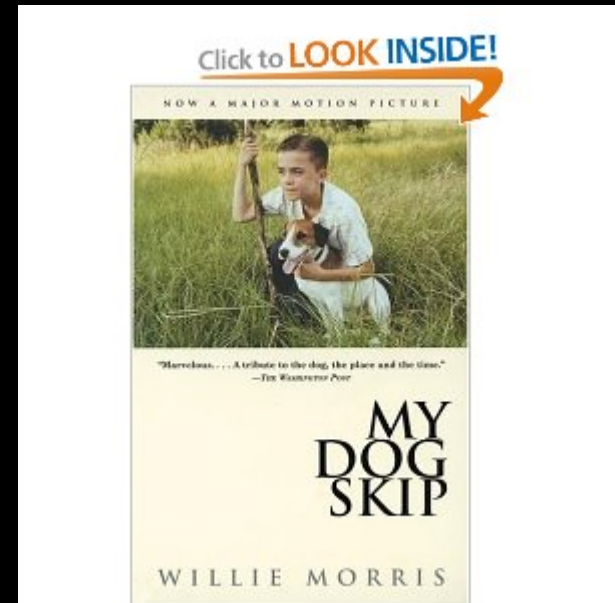
MY DEAR MOLLIE

- A collection of late nineteenth-century letters by a Texas sheep rancher to his sweetheart in which he reveals the painful loneliness of life on the plains.



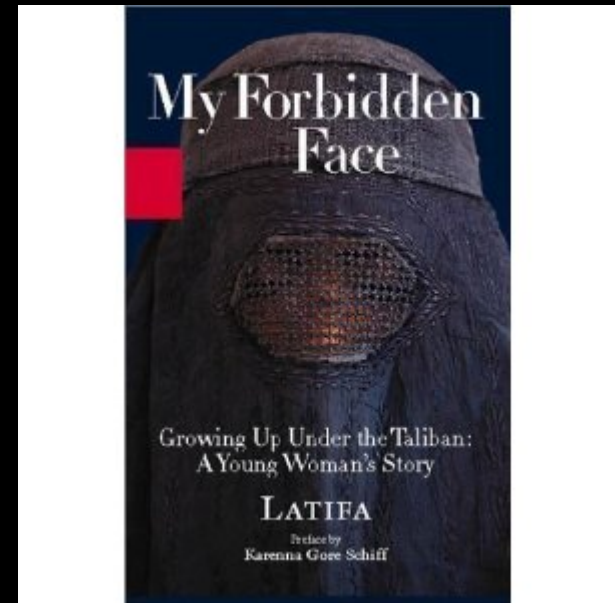
MY DOG SKIP

- This book tells the story of a dog and his closest companion, the author, during their growing years in a small town in 1940s Mississippi



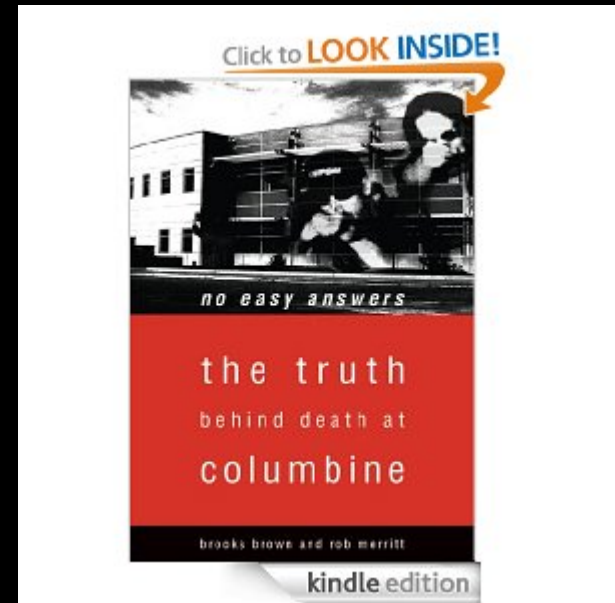
MY FORBIDDEN FACE

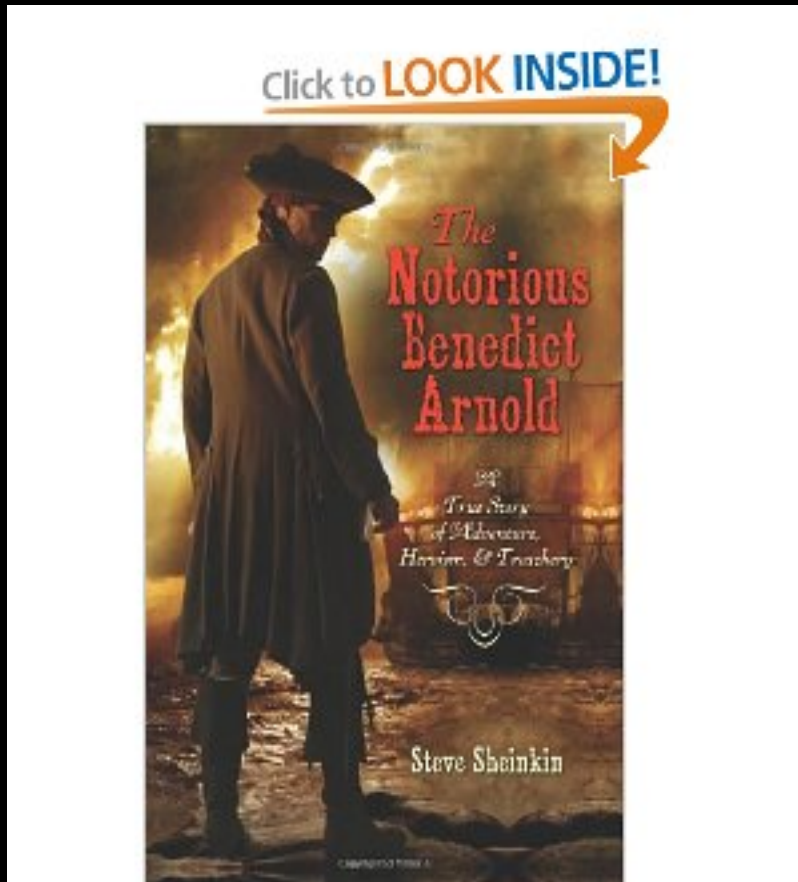


NO EASY ANSWERS

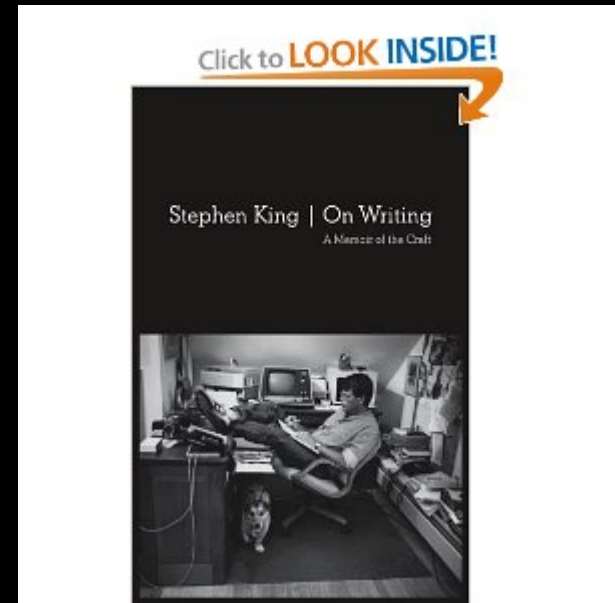
THE NOTORIOUS BENEDICT ARNOLD



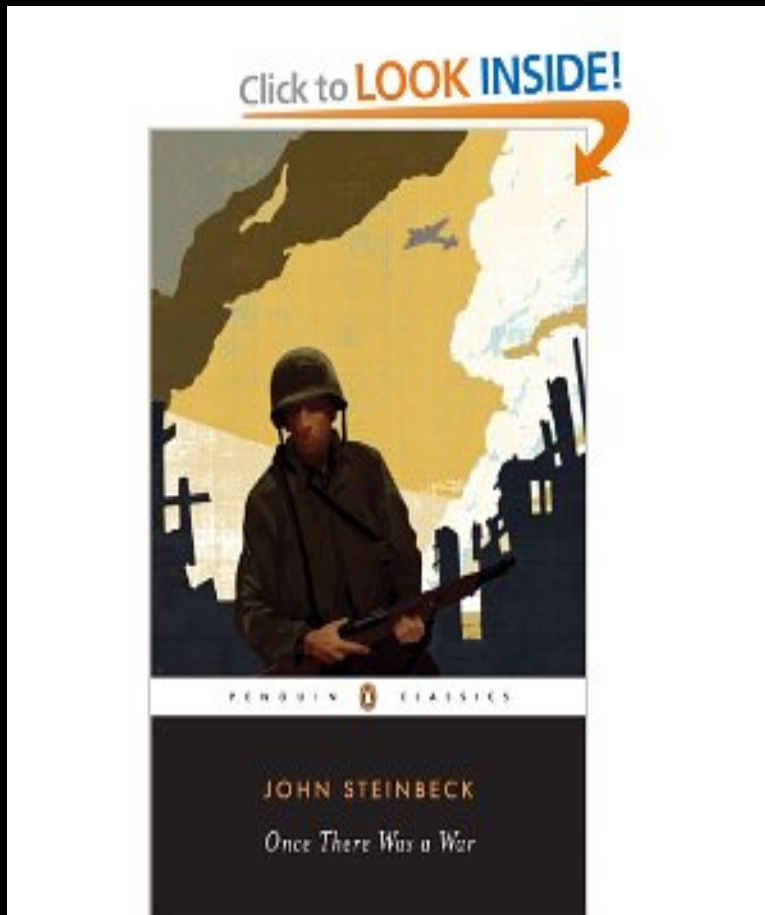
- This introduction to the life of Benedict Arnold highlights not only the traitorous actions that made him legendary, but also his heroic involvement in the American Revolution.

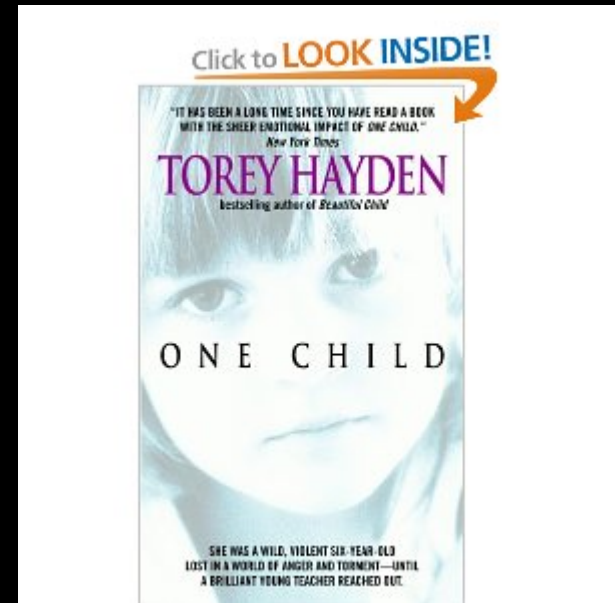
ONCE THERE WAS A WAR



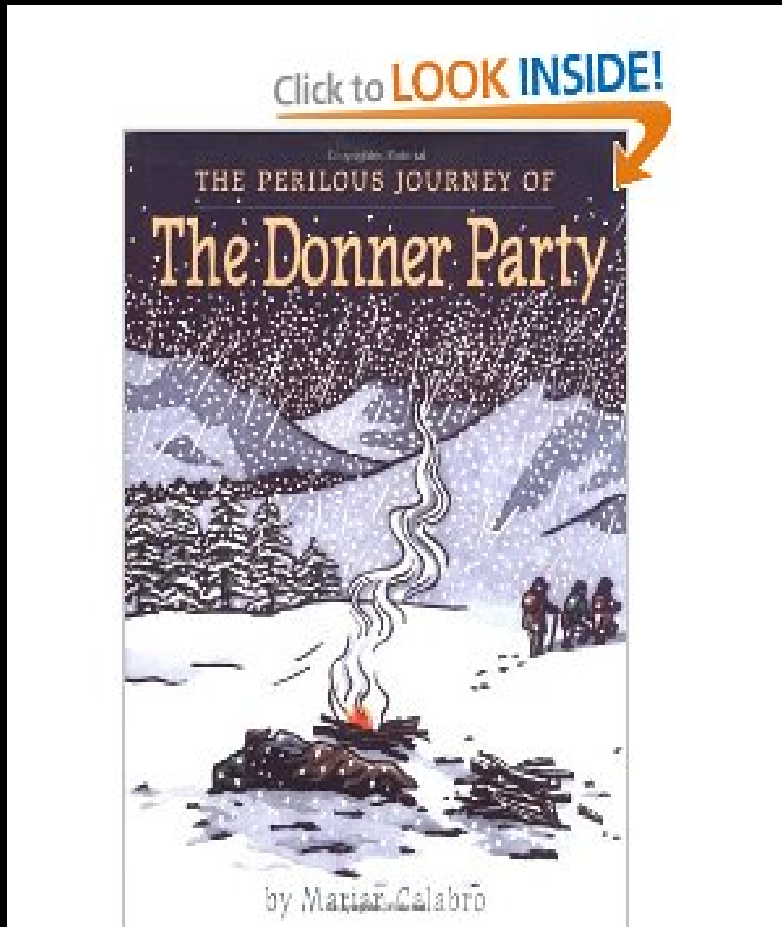
- This book contains the humane and hard-hitting dispatches that John Steinbeck filed for the "New York Herald Tribune" at the height of World War II.

- Sensing something valuable beneath the rage of a 6-year-old in her class, a compassionate teacher works to reclaim a lost child.



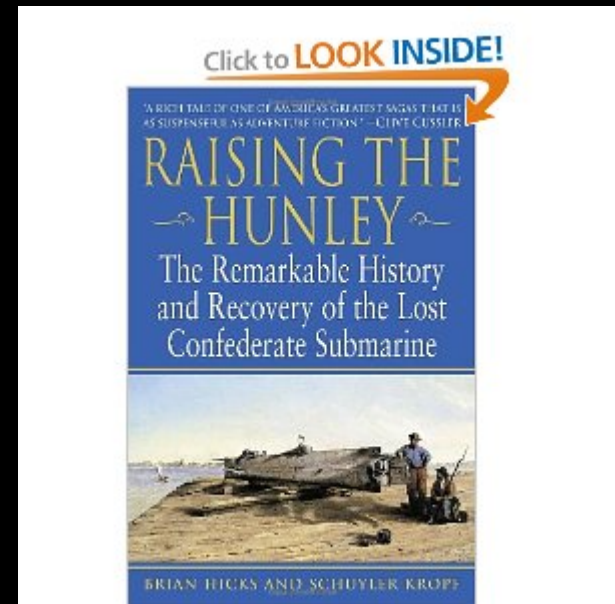
PERILOUS JOURNEY OF DONNER PARTY

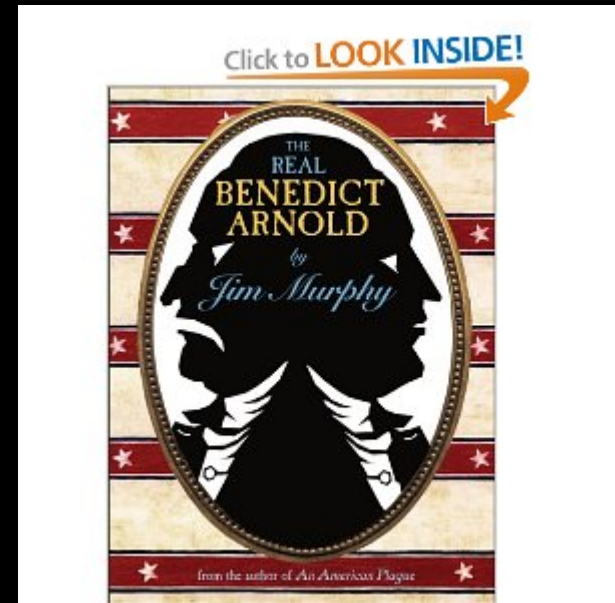
RAISING THE HUNLEY

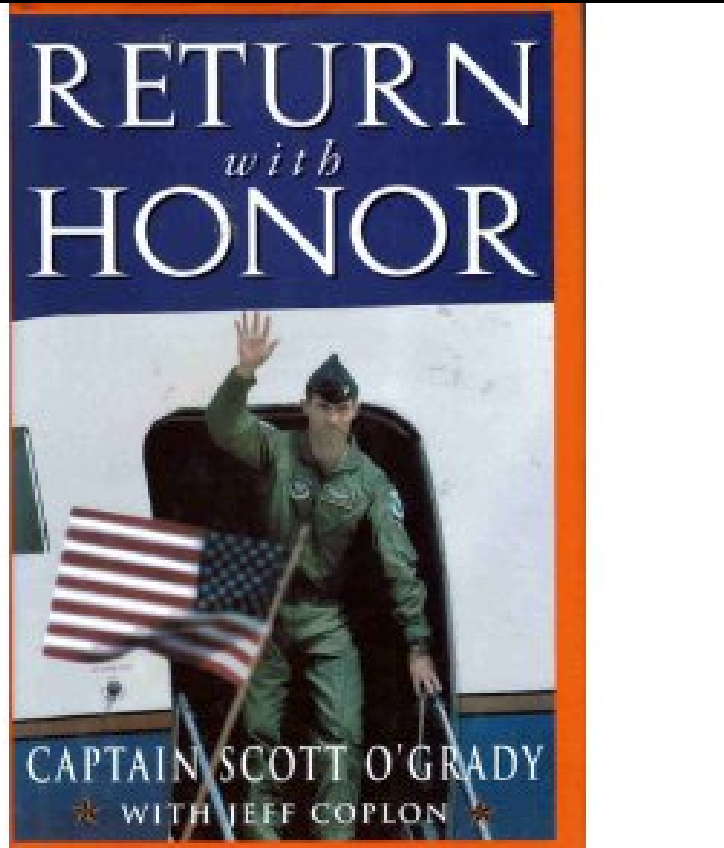


THE REAL BENEDICT ARNOLD

- This biography portrays Benedict Arnold as a brilliant man, consistently undervalued by his peers, who made a choice that continues to reverberate through American history.



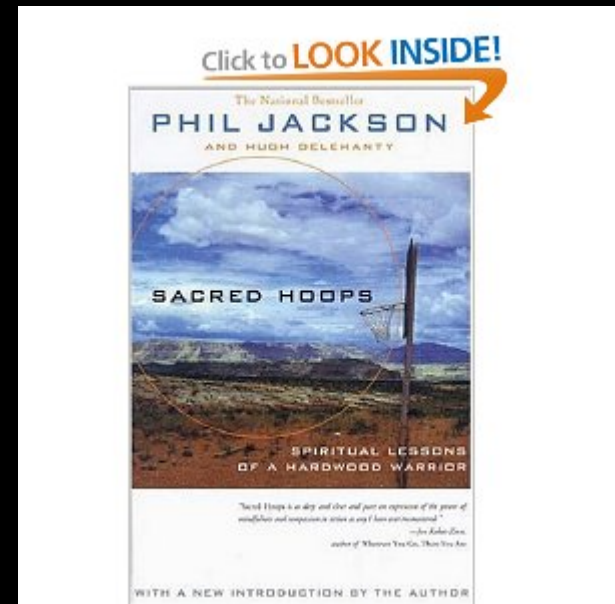
RETURN WITH HONOR



- An American fighter pilot's heroic tale of survival behind enemy lines in Bosnia.

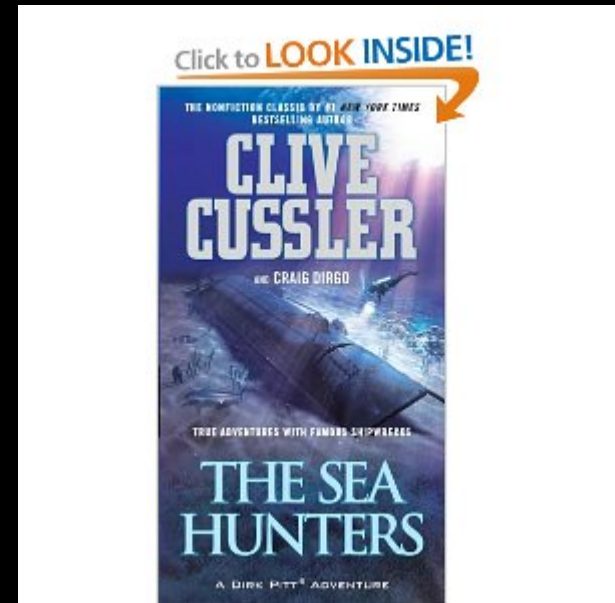
SACRED HOOPS

- An inside look at the higher wisdom of teamwork.



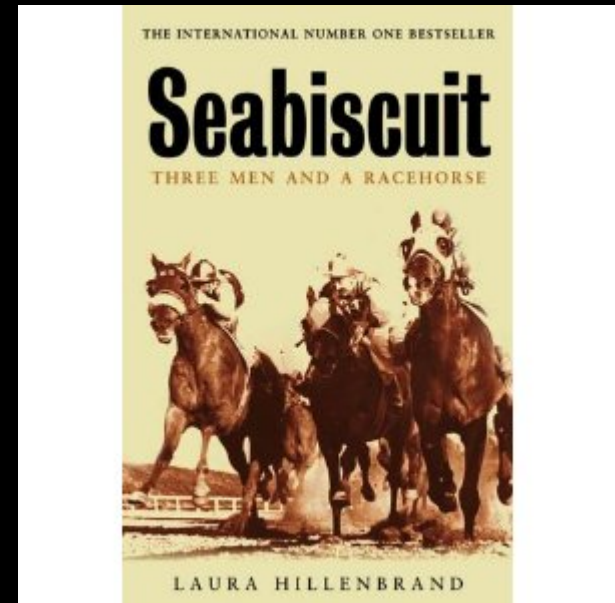
THE SEA HUNTERS

- This book describes how three men worked together to turn a rough-hewn, undersized horse into one of the fastest horses in racing history.



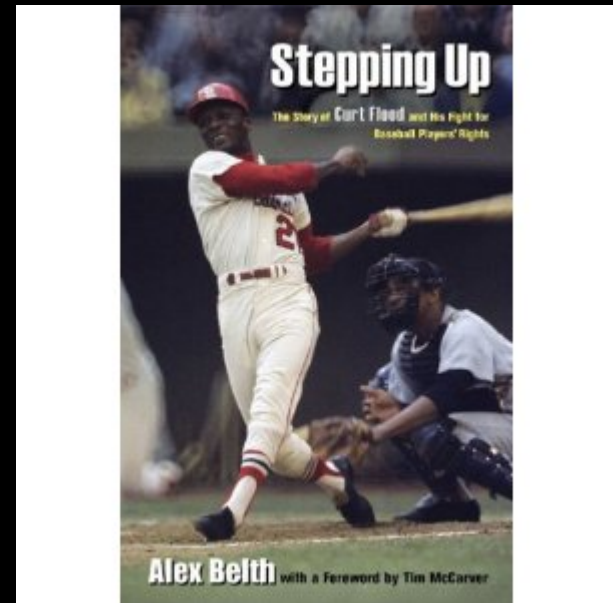
SOUL SURFER

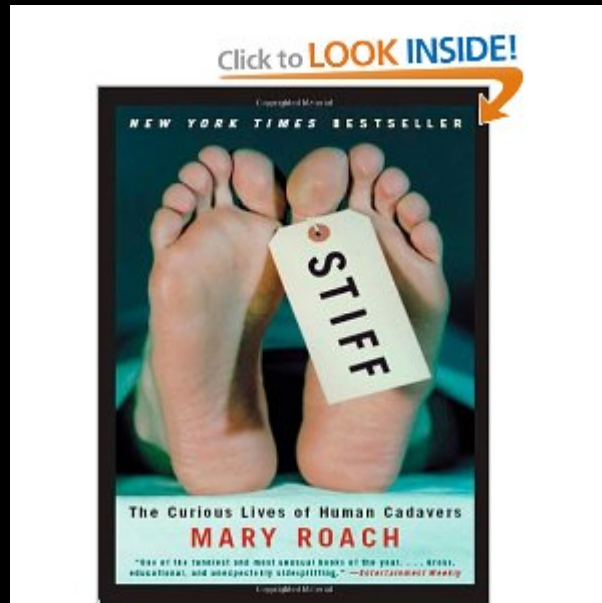
STEPPING UP

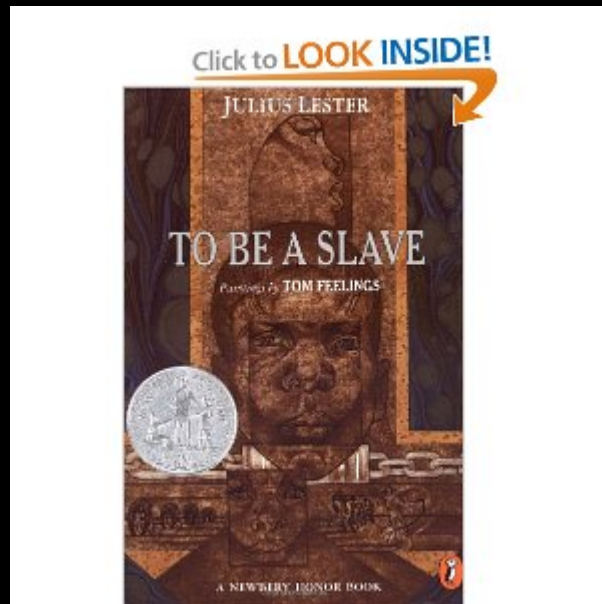
STIFF

- This book explores how human cadavers have been used throughout history



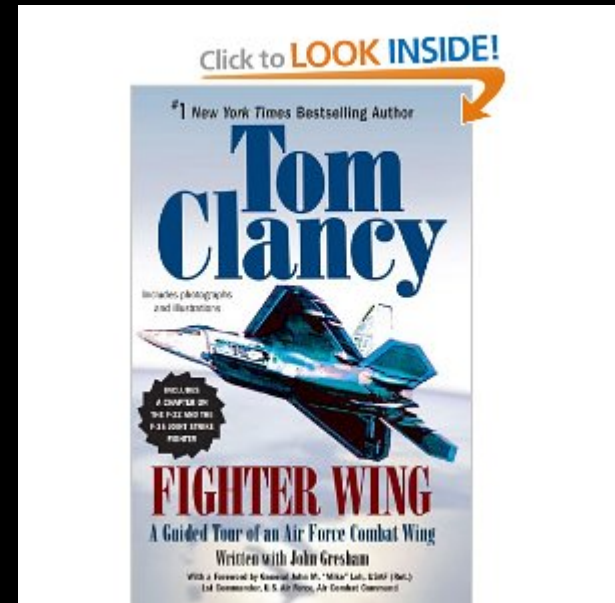
TO BE A SLAVE

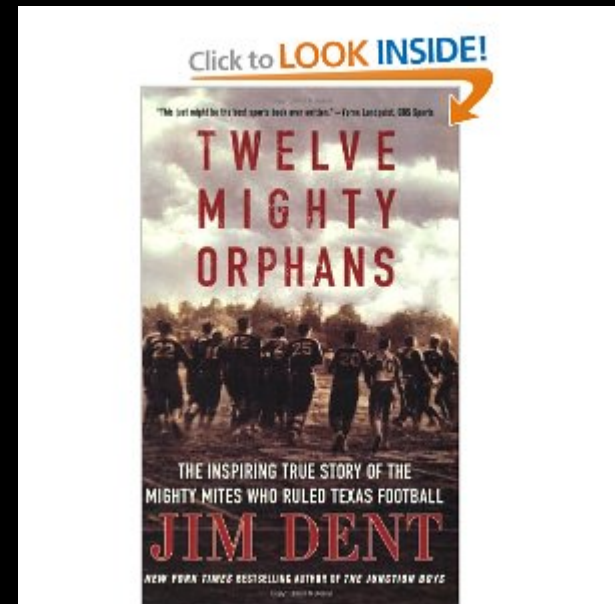
FIGHTER WING

- Tom Clancy explores the U.S. Air Force's elite, the Fighter Wing, with an insider's look at the planes, the technology, and the people.

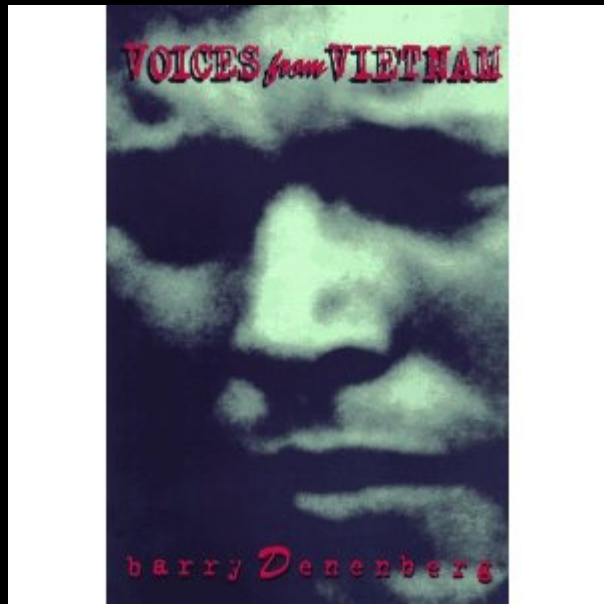


TWELVE MIGHTY ORPHANS

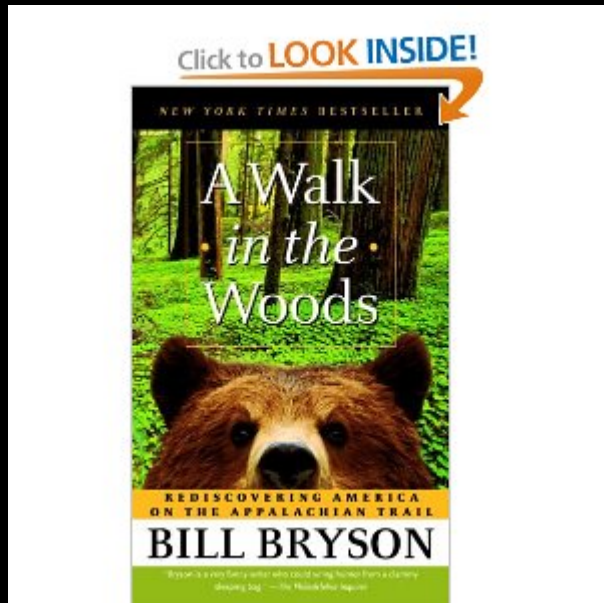


VOICES FROM VIETNAM



- Stories about what it was like to be in Vietnam, told by the American men and women who served there.

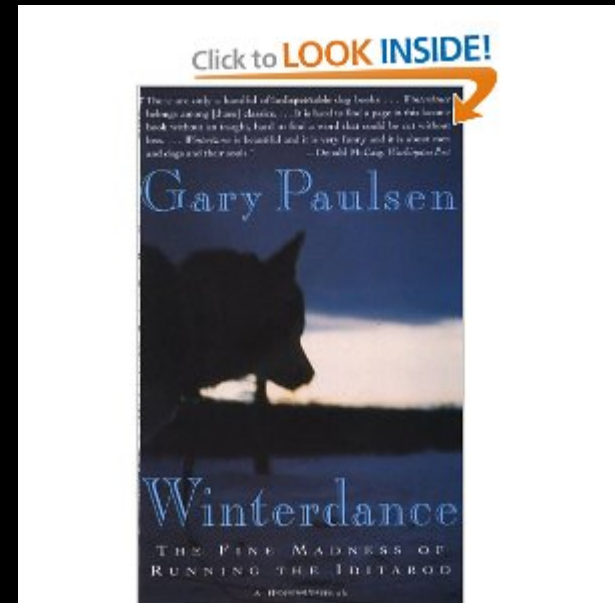
A WALK IN THE WOODS



- After twenty years in Britain, Bill Bryson decided to reacquaint himself with his native country by walking the 2,100 mile Appalachian Trail.

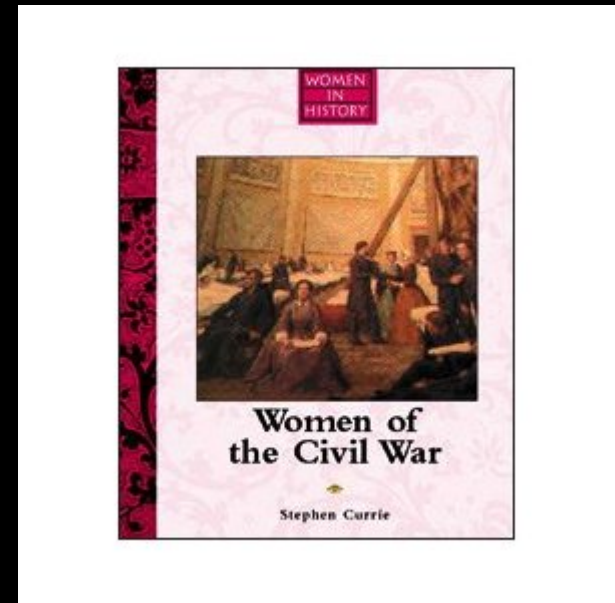
WINTERDANCE

- This book is an unforgettable account of the author Gary Paulsen's most ambitious quest -- to know a world beyond his knowing, to train for and run the Iditarod.



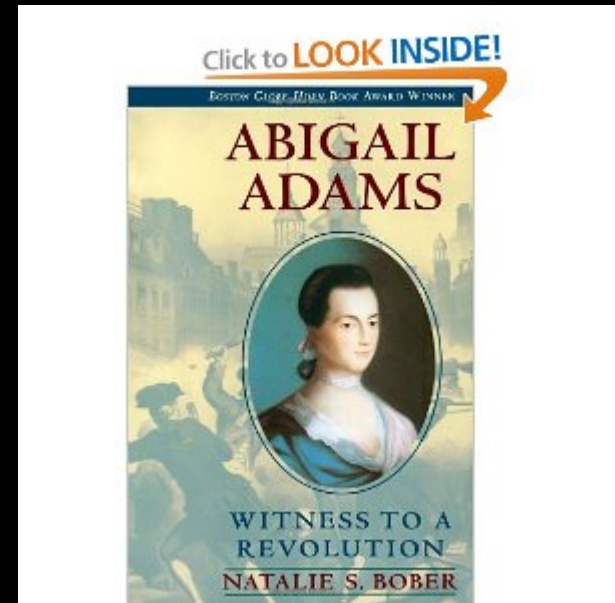

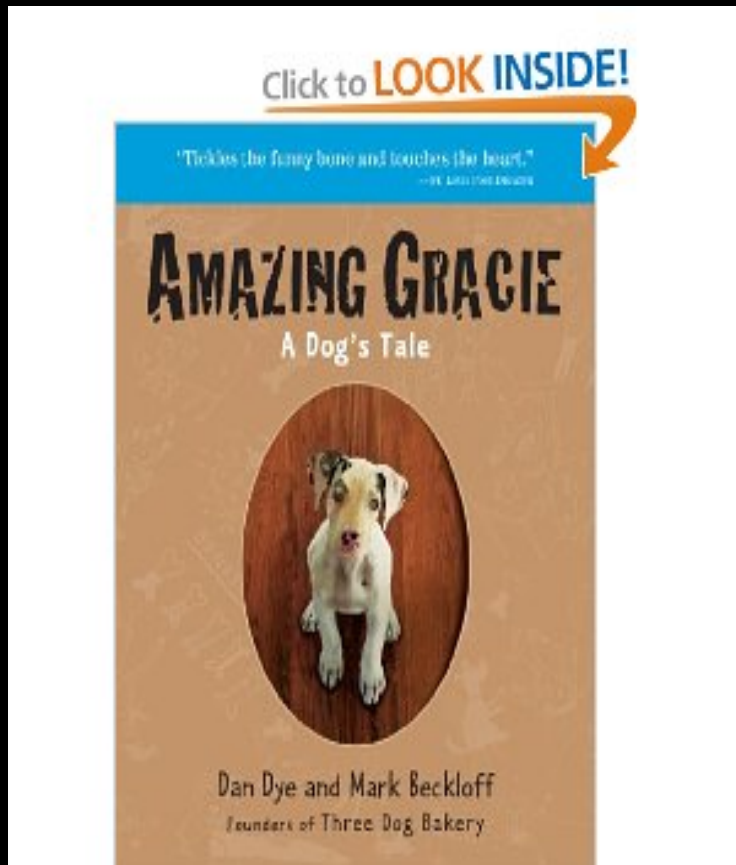
- This is a collection of true stories about men and women who have put their own lives on the line to save others.

- This is the true story of a young girl whose ingenuity and courage saved many Jewish people after her entire family was killed by the Nazis



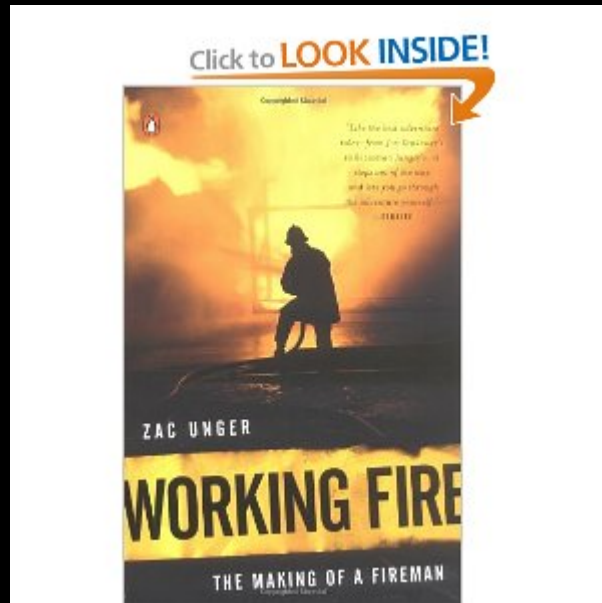
AMAZING GRACIE-A DOG'S TALE

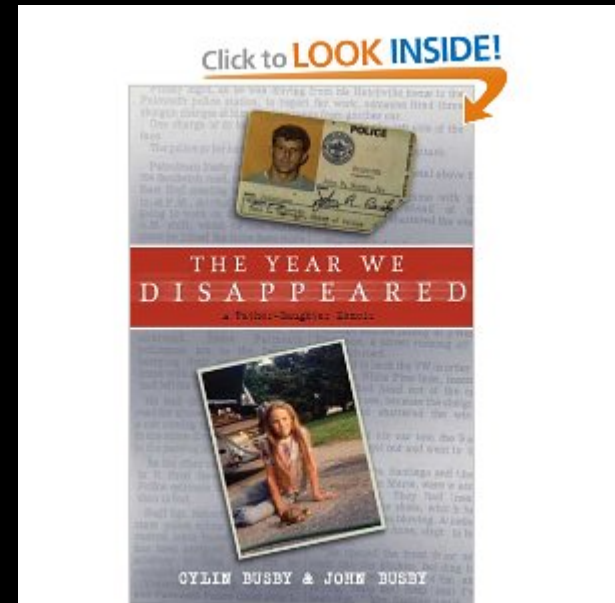
WORKING FIRE-MAKING OF A FIREMAN

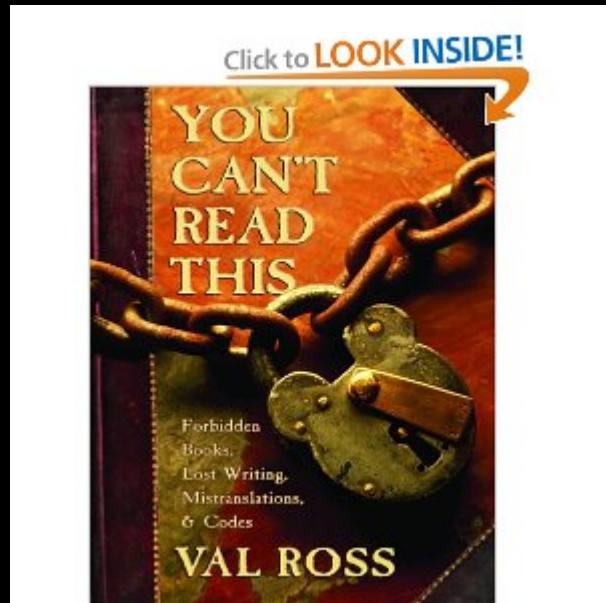


YEAR WE DISAPPEARED
