PARIS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING REGISTRATION

All Paris High School Students who drive a vehicle to school will be required to display a parking pass. The intent of this program is to create a safe, secure environment for drivers and their vehicles. If the driver does not adhere to safety guidelines or school policy, parking privileges may be revoked.

INITIAL COST - FREE REPLACEMENT COST \$1.00

HOW TO OBTAIN A PARKING PASS:

- 1. Read Carefully the PHS Parking Policy
- 2. Completely Fill Out the Parking Registration Form
- 3. Make sure Parent or Guardian signs the Registration Form.

WHERE TO OBTAIN A PARKING PASS:

Parking Passes will be available in the high school office. All students must have a Parking Pass displayed in their vehicle beginning August 20^{th} .

PARIS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING POLICY

- 1. Student Parking Location: Parking lot located behind the old Paris Board of Education office.
- 2. Parking Permits must be displayed on the backside of the rearview mirror and be visible through the front windshield.
- 3. Any vehicle not displaying a parking permit is subject to immediate towing.
- 4. Vehicles are to be backed into parking spaces for easy exit at the end of the day.
- 5. School Buses have the right of way at all times.
- 6. Students will drive in a SAFE and REASONABLE manner at all times.
- 7. A 15mph speed limit will be observed on ALL parts of school property.
- 8. Students may use the Faculty Parking Lot for after school activities.
