Primary Focus

- o Many students have most their classes done and have several periods of study hall or leave early their senior year
- o Through ODE's Senior Only program – seniors can participate in career tech certificate only training programs

Important Concepts

- In the PRCTC example, the CTPD is the lead
- Home schools provide program input and referrals of students
- PRCTC secondary education partners with the PRCTC adult education department (Ohio Technical Center, OTC)

Timeline (continued)

- o Review of current OTC staff and credentials
 - o 12-hour permit currently requires a 4-year degree
 - o Long term sub license and CTE-36 alternative
 - o Working on a law change
- o Asked area students to complete a program interest survey

Timeline (continued)

- o Met with associate schools and asked for feedback
 - o Scheduling
 - o EMIS credits
 - o FAQ and other concerns
- o Ensured appropriateness for age & developed schedules
- o Piloted with a few schools first semester
- o Started enrollment process with the OTC

As of Today

- o 12 students currently enrolled in the pilot
- o Second semester coming fast with expanded schools/offerings
- o Getting additional interest due to new graduation requirements
- o OTC support using WorkKeys remediation curriculum
- o Advocating for additional industry recognized credentials
