

Fairfield Union High School Counseling Office-Scholarship Listings

Douglas Barr Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship is awarded to one senior from Fairfield Union, Pickerington Central, and Pickerington North for the first year of college. Applicant must attach an essay regarding his or her definition of character and the benefits of helping others. The scholarship amount is \$1000.00 sent directly to the student's college or university. Application deadline is May 30th, 2019. The scholarship information has been emailed to all seniors and will be available in the counseling office.

Operation Round Up Foundation Scholarship: This scholarship is for high school seniors whose household is served by The Energy Cooperative and the parent/guardian must be participating in the Operation Round Up Foundation program on their monthly billing. Each scholarship is worth \$2500.00. This scholarship was created to reward those students expressing the following values: accountability, integrity, innovation and community involvement. Alpha Delta Kappa Educational Sorority Scholarship: The organization will award two \$1000.00 scholarships to students entering the educational profession. To be eligible, students must complete the application and have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. Students must be either a full-time high school or college student. Students must be able to provide two references as well. Deadline for the scholarship is April 15th, 2019. Applications can be found in the counseling office.

Ursula Feer Farfel Scholarship: This scholarship is for a high school graduating senior who has been admitted to Ohio University and is majoring in French, German, or Spanish. This scholarship is worth half of in-state tuition for students renewable for four years. Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and show financial need. Please email or see Mrs. Poston for an application. Deadline for this scholarship is April 15th 2019.

Fairfield County Farm Bureau: The number of scholarships will be based on the number of qualified applicants. The deadline for this scholarship is April 1st. Applicant must be a senior in high school. The applicant or applicant's parent/guardian must be a Fairfield County Farm Bureau member in good standing. Applications can be picked up in the counseling office.

Pleasantville LaSertoma: Seniors applying for college in the Fall of 2019 may be eligible for a \$1000.00 grant. The criteria for this scholarship is: financial need, scholastic achievement, community involvement and leadership, future educational plans. Application can be found in the counseling office. Application deadline is April 30th, 2019.

Fairfield Union FUEA Scholarship: This scholarship for the 2018-2019 academic year is funded by donations by Fairfield Union School District staff as well as the Kroger Community Rewards

participants. The scholarship is in its 38th year and is to help our district's students pursue post-secondary education. This is a one-time \$1000.00 scholarship for two recipients this year. Children of Fairfield Union teachers are given preference but are not automatic recipients. The criteria include: Financial need, academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, and rigor of courses taken. Applications can be found on the high school website or in the counseling office. The deadline for submission is March 29th to Mrs. Cupp. No late submissions will be accepted.

Keller Family Chiropractic Scholarship: This \$500 scholarship is for a graduating senior of a Fairfield County school or its equivalent who is interested in alternative health care. This would include the following fields: Chiropractic, Homeopathy, Licensed Massage Therapy, Naturopathy, etc. which will be pursued at an accredited school. The deadline is April 15th and applications can be found in the counseling office.

William D. Squires Scholarship: 15 scholarships will be awarded to Ohio students. The scholarship amount is \$4000.00 per year and are renewable for up to \$16000.00. Scholarship deadline is April 5th. A student must have an EFC of less than 7000 to apply. Applicants must have good character and be highly-motivated with a minimum GPA of 3.2. Workforce Demand Scholarship at Terra State Community College: Terra State is offering to high school seniors the opportunity to receive a 5 semester scholarship that offers a tuition-free education in qualifying programs.
