LORAIN CITY SCHOOLS COVID-19 RESPONSE PROTOCOL STAY AT HOME GUIDELINES

FLAGGED AS CLOSE CONTACT

Written release from local health department

NOT TESTED

10 days after symptom onset and 24+ hours without fever and improved symptoms

PENDING TEST RESULTS

Until results are known

POSITIVE TEST RESULTS

Written release from local health department

NEGATIVE

24+ hours without fever and improved symptoms

ALTERNATIVE DIAGNOSIS

24+ hours without fever and improved symptoms



CLOSE CONTACT | Someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset.

ISOLATION | Separates people with an infectious disease from people who are not sick. **QUARANTINE** | Separates people who are exposed to an infectious disease to see if they may become sick
