# LORAIN CITY SCHOOLS COVID-19 RESPONSE PROTOCOL

## STAY AT HOME GUIDELINES

**FLAGGED AS  
CLOSE CONTACT**

Written release from  
local health department

**NOT TESTED**

10 days after symptom  
onset and 24+ hours  
without fever and  
improved symptoms

**PENDING TEST  
RESULTS**

Until results are known

**POSITIVE TEST  
RESULTS**

Written release from  
local health department

**NEGATIVE**

24+ hours without fever  
and improved symptoms

**ALTERNATIVE  
DIAGNOSIS**

24+ hours without fever  
and improved symptoms



**CLOSE CONTACT** | Someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset.

**ISOLATION** | Separates people with an infectious disease from people who are not sick.

**QUARANTINE** | Separates people who are exposed to an infectious disease to see if they may become sick

Under the guidance of local health department, this guidance is subject to change as new data is released.
