What will I need to bring?

- **Updated Emergency Medical Authorization** We will provide blank copies to be filled out when you arrive, if needed.
- Proof of Address Must include name, address and date
 - o Utility Bill (last 60 days) or
 - Voter registration card
 - Bank statement
 - o Government Check
 - Pay Check
 - o Property Taxes
 - Housing Rental Contract (current year)
 - Mortgage Documents (current year)
 - Official state or local government letter or document on letterhead or with official seal.

If the parent/guardian does not have a POA in their name and resides with someone (friend/family) we need a proof of address in the name of the person they reside with...

No cell phone bills, No insurance bills, No medical documents, No court documents

What safety protocols will be in place?

This will be a curbside pickup, you will not need to get out of your car, your computer will be wiped down with disinfectant, and anyone greeting your or handling your computer will be wearing a mask and gloves.
