



How are Students Screened for Possible Disabilities?

- Students are put through the IST (Instruction Support Team) Process
- Some pre-screening throughout this process may take place
- After the 60-day intervention, student might be referred for psychological testing

What Pre-Referral Procedures are Required?

- Regular education teachers complete IST Request and Interview Forms
- Parent may request a review
- Counselor/Social Worker/Principal may request a review

How and When are Parents Informed of Possible Problems?

- Phone Call
- Follow Up with a Letter
- Parents are included in the IST meetings
- Mid-marking period reviews are sent to parents – however, if struggling, contact should be made as soon as possible

How are Curriculum-Based Procedures Developed and Used?

- Curriculum Committee meets with staff to help develop procedures ~ special education is part of the curriculum team
- Assessments are done throughout the year and during the IST time period

Who Provides Classroom Observation Data?

- Staff – including teachers (both regular and special education teachers), counselors, social worker, principal, paraprofessionals, psychologist...those involved on the team are invited to include data they have observed

Who Monitors the Process?

- Administrative Staff
