The Peace Officer Basic Training Academy at GCCC began on December 9th. This program offers an 845-hour course with curriculum designed to meet the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC) standards.

The current class includes six cadets, including sponsorships from Greene County Sheriff's Office and Warren County Sheriff's Office. Upon successful completion, graduates are eligible to take the state certification exam, which qualifies them for employment as law enforcement officers across Ohio.
