



NEXT STEPS TO CONTINUE YOUR EDUCATION

Step 1

Review the Payment Options on the Financial Aid Resources Handout

- ✓ If paying for the program via cash, credit card, or Agency Assistance continue to Step 2
- ✓ If interested in funding from Ohio Means Jobs, please refer to handout for process
- ✓ If interested in applying for Federal Financial Aid (Pell Grant and/or Direct Loans), fill out the FAFSA. Call 440.774.1051 ext. 22254 to schedule a financial aid appointment to discuss eligibility and your options in regards to paying for the program. You must bring an unexpired valid government issued photo identification (ID) and documentation of high school completion status to your financial aid appointment. After the financial aid appointment, you will continue to Step 2

Step 2

WorkKeys Assessment

- Once you have completed the information session and financial aid appointment, you will receive an email with a link to register for the WorkKeys Assessment
- Cost is \$75.00 and you should plan on testing for 3 hours (each subject is 1 hour)
- Retake \$25.00 per subject area – only one retake allowable per subject
- The test fee must be paid in full to schedule
- Upon request, prep packages can be obtained from the front office. The three subject areas are: Applied Mathematics, Workplace Documents, Graphic Literacy

Step 3

Register for the Program

- You will be sent an email with a link to register for the program.
- \$100.00 deposit is required or agency voucher.

Step 4
