- ✓ If interested in applying for Federal Financial Aid (Pell Grant and/or Direct Loans), fill out the FAFSA. Call 440.774.1051 ext. 22322 to schedule a financial aid appointment to discuss eligibility and your options in regards to paying for the program. You must bring an unexpired valid government issued photo identification (ID) and documentation of high school completion status to your financial aid appointment. Copy of high school diploma or GED is required. After the financial aid appointment, you will continue to Step 2
