(Protocol-1st injection is given, results are read and documented in 48-72 hours. 2nd injection is given no sooner than 7 days and no later than 21 days apart and that is also read and documented in 48-72 hours. This must be read by a nurse or doctor only.

- A.) You must receive a 2-step Mantoux test for the Tuberculosis (TB) Screening. Both injections and readings must be documented on this health form.

- B.) If you are not able to take the TB screening or have tested positive in the past, a chest X-Ray will have to be done with negative results for participation in clinical rotations.

Please take this form to the health care facility where you will be receiving your injections. The health care provider needs to document the necessary information listed below. You may also check with your local health department to have this screening done.
