

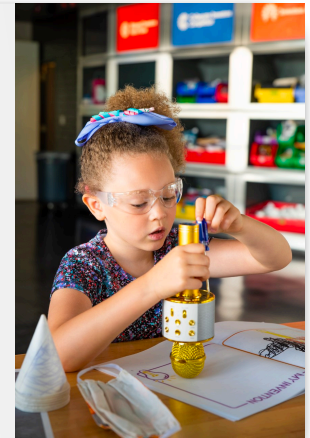
## Elementary Summer Programs Cabell County Schools
