1	Emergency Treatment
2	
3	The Board recognizes that schools are responsible for providing first aid or emergency treatment
4	to a student in case of sudden illness or injury; however, further medical attention is the
5	responsibility of a parent or guardian.
6	
7	The District requires that every parent or guardian provide a telephone number where a parent or
8	designee of a parent may be reached in case of an emergency.
9	
10	When a student is injured, staff will provide immediate care and attention until relieved by a
11 12	superior, a nurse, or a doctor. The District will employ its normal procedures to address medical emergencies without regard to the existence of a do not resuscitate (DNR) request. A principal
13	or designated staff member will call a parent or parental designee so that the parent may arrange
14	for care or treatment of an injured student.
15	
16	When a student develops symptoms of illness while at school, a responsible school official will
17	do the following:

19	Isolate the student from other children to a room or area segregated for that purpose;
20	
21	Inform a parent or guardian as soon as possible about the illness and request a parent or
22	guardian to pick up the child; and
23	
24	Report each case of suspected communicable disease the same day by telephone to a
25	local health authority or as soon as possible thereafter if a health authority cannot be
26	reached the same day.
27	
28	When a parent or guardian cannot be reached, and it is the judgment of a principal or other
29	person in charge that immediate medical attention is required, an injured student may be taken
30	directly to a hospital. Once located, a parent or a guardian is responsible for continuing
31	treatment or for making other arrangements.
