COURSE OVERVIEW:

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ONC BOCES Career Pathways consists of a series of 1/2 day programs offering students, ages 14-21 years, an opportunity to develop the skills they will need to live, learn and earn within the community. It is our goal to provide each student with the support and guidance needed to ensure that the much-feared transition from school to the adult world is as smooth and seamless as possible.

ONC BOCES Career Pathways meets the needs of disabled students by making available several educational programs. Each of these programs provide different levels of educational programming, varying degrees of support (physical and emotional), and a diversity of in-house and community work experiences (simple to complex).

Career Pathways begins with a Level II Vocational Assessment and comprehensive transition plan. These procedures are designed to give students, parents, staff & other service providers a program "road map" most suitable for success.

The choice of which program is most appropriate depends upon the specific needs of the student being referred for services.

CP I: CAREER PREP & AWARENESS

The 15:1:1 Career Prep and Awareness program is available to IEP students. This program provides students with an awareness of numerous career possibilities, while at the same time developing the basic foundation skills needed for entry level employability.



CP II: CAREER EXPLORATION

The 15:1:1 Career Exploration program is available to IEP students. Students continue exploring careers through increased visits and participation in CTE training curriculum/ modules. These include: Auto, Building Trades, Cosmetology, Criminal Justice, Health Occupations, Information Technology, Natural Resources, Visual Arts Media and Welding and Innovative Agriculture



CP III/IV: CAREER FOCUS

The 15:1:1 Career Focus program is available to IEP students with an approximate age range of 16-21 years. This program is a community work training program offered to students. Small groups of students rotate through a variety of community businesses and are accompanied by a job coach who will assist with:

- ⇒ Orientation to the business
- ⇒ Specific job skill training
- **⇒** Problem solving

Adaptations to the work environment as needed:

Students receive 80% of their work training at a community business where they are expected to assume all the responsibilities of an employee within the company, and 20% of their time in the classroom receiving instruction in areas such as: Self assessment, personal development, job skills assessment, portfolio creation and independent living.
