## Supply List 2026-2027

### 4th Grade:

- scissors
- glue sticks (3)
- 24 pack of crayons (no markers or colored pencils)
- pre-sharpened pencils 2 - 12 packs
- pocket folder with prongs (4 - different colors - red, blue, green, yellow)
- expo brand markers (1 pack)
- zippered pouch (1)
- yellow highlighter (1)
- tissues (2 boxes)
- earbuds/headphones (no bluetooth)

### Optional for 4th grade:

- paper towels
- hand sanitizer

### 5th Grade:

- filler paper
- XL book cover (needs to fit a 10"x11" book)
- #2 pencils (24)
- 12 pack of colored pencils or crayons
- spiral notebook (1) 8 ½ x 11 (100 pages or more)
- glue sticks (12)
- scissors
- pocket with prong folders (5 different colors - orange, blue, green, yellow, purple)
- dry erase markers
- yellow highlighters (2)
- composition notebook (1)
- pencil pouch (no plastic boxes)
- tissues (2 boxes)
- earbuds - no bluetooth

### Optional for 5th grade:

- clorox wipes
- hand sanitizer

### 6th grade:

- Pencils (the more, the better)
- 1 folder with pockets
- 2 (1.5") binders (science, ELA)
- 1 (2") binder (math)
- Headphones (that plug in, not Bluetooth)
- 24 Colored Pencils
- boxes of Tissues (2)
- Rolls of paper towels

### Optional for 6th grade:

- cinch sack
- Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS (this calculator can be used for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade)

### 7th grade:

- Folder with pockets and prongs (at least 2)
- Pencils/pens
- headphones (plug in not bluetooth)
- Tissues
- Dry erase markers (4 pack) Expo preferred
- Glue stick (3 pack)
- Spiral bound notebook (7th grade math)

### Optional for 7th grade:

- wireless mouse
- Clorox wipes
- paper towels (1 Roll)
- hand sanitizer
- cinch sack

### Important notes for all grades:

- no backpacks are allowed in the classrooms
- earbuds/headphones have to be able to be plugged into the chromebook - no Bluetooth
- locks for lockers are not allowed at the 4th and 5th grade level, but are optional for 6th and 7th grade
