

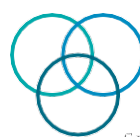

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

The Nardonias Schools always score well on state mandated tests, but we are so much more than test scores. Students show incredible achievements in academics, athletics and the arts, and provide heartfelt community service. The Nardonias Schools focus on the whole-child. Our greatest successes aren't measured on a test.

Schools in Nardonias Hills City School District have an average math proficiency score of 72% (versus the Ohio public school average of 50%) and reading proficiency score of 79% (versus the 57% statewide average).

Nardonias Hills City School District is ranked in the top 10% of all 897 school districts in Ohio (based on the combined math and reading proficiency testing data) for the 2020-2021 school year.
