Dear Little Flower Community,

As I announced at the community meeting this past Sunday, we have been blessed in recent years with generous bequests and I am pleased to share a number of infrastructure improvements to our Parish School which will set up our community for the future. This investment has been approved by the Archbishop and the Building and Real Estate Office; with funds approved for July 1<sup>st</sup> distribution. We are confident that these improvements will result in a better experience for our current and future community members. In order to continue our mission, it is imperative that we repair, restore and beautify our school, just as we have recently with our church, organ and carillon.

These improvements include mechanical upgrades for airflow and circulation for a healthier learning environment and electrical infrastructure installation for a new intercom system and easy technology upgrades for years to come allowing us to keep up with rapidly evolving teaching systems. A new entrance and lobby will improve safety and security and allow our disabled and elderly parishioners to have better access to our facilities, including ADA compliant restrooms. Our kitchen will be replaced to better serve our community events, as well to expand use and hands on learning opportunities. The overall facelift to the school will reflect the energy, strength and community that is Little Flower.

Over the past few months, various representatives of the community, from our Parish Council to our School Board, Finance and Fundraising Committees and many more, have been meeting to work through proposals. Beginning with last year's endowment ideation activities (before the COVID-19 lockdown), we have been able to make improvements to the school and parish based on your inputs. Below is a listing of what has been accomplished, what is in work and what we now plan to address (denoted by the blue stars) to rebuild our campus for generations to come.

We are thankful for all that our parishioners and community members have done to make Little Flower what it is today. We give thanks to God for what He has done, and we trust in His will for our parish and school.
