Community

Montrose is located in rural Western Colorado and serves the educational needs of 6,300 students in 2 traditional high schools, 3 middle schools, 6 elementary schools, 1 hybrid school, and 1 alternative school. The area population is approximately 32,000 and the largest employers are the school district, hospital, and local government. In addition, the service industry, light manufacturing, and agriculture provide jobs. The median household income for the city/county is \$41,717/\$43,999 and 27% of adults hold a 4-year college degree or higher.

School

Peak Academy is a public school in the Montrose County School District serving students in Kindergarten through 12th grade in a hybrid environment (high school students complete work in-class and online). District wide, 49% of students receive free or reduced lunch, 39% are Hispanic and 61% are Non-hispanic.
