



Rodrigue Painted in 1971, The Breaux Bridge Band is a classic among George Rodrigue's paintings. Along with similar works from this period, it defines his style as a pictorial champion of the Cajun culture, recording snapshots of time within turn-of-the-century Southwest Louisiana. Ironically, however, it is only on the artist's canvas, and not in reality, that this band connects Acadiana's heritage to the music that today, along with Cajun food and joie de vivre, characterizes a culture. "There really was a Breaux Bridge Band around 1900," explains George Rodrigue, "but it was called a 'Classical Music Band.' They were very popular at the time. The members were Cajuns and Europeans, and their repertoire was classical. It had nothing to do with Cajun music." **Donated by:** Alexis Wilson






