- **Attention Class of 2026:** The health and wellness of all students attending Wellington Schools is a top priority. We want to ensure that students are up-to-date- with the State of Ohio required vaccines to provide a healthy environment within the schools and the community. Before students enter the 12th grade, they must have received two doses of the meningitis vaccine by age 16 or one dose if the first dose was given after age 16. Contact your medical provider or make an appointment at Lorain County Public Health to receive the required vaccination. Once you have received the vaccine, provide a printed record as proof of vaccination to the WHS office.
