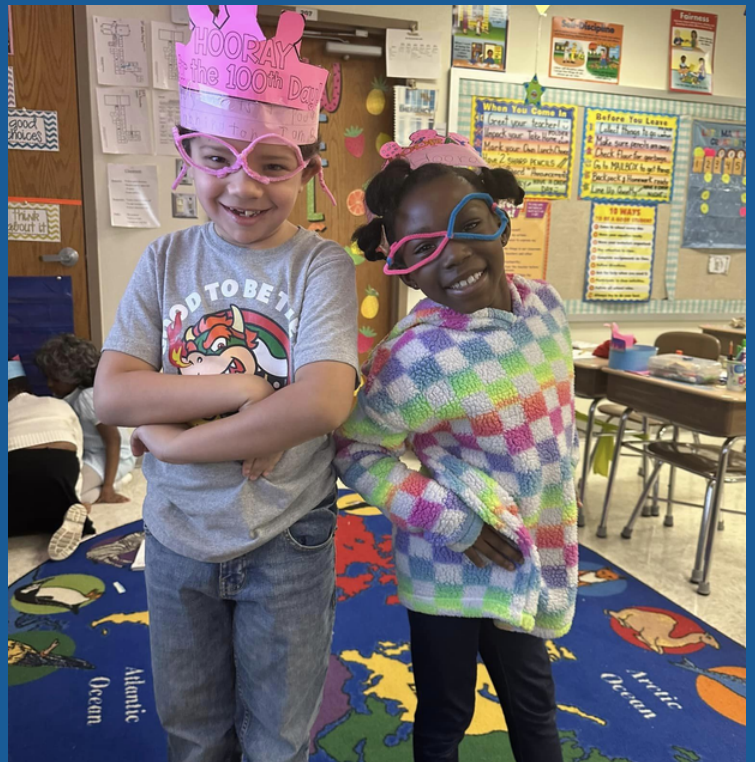


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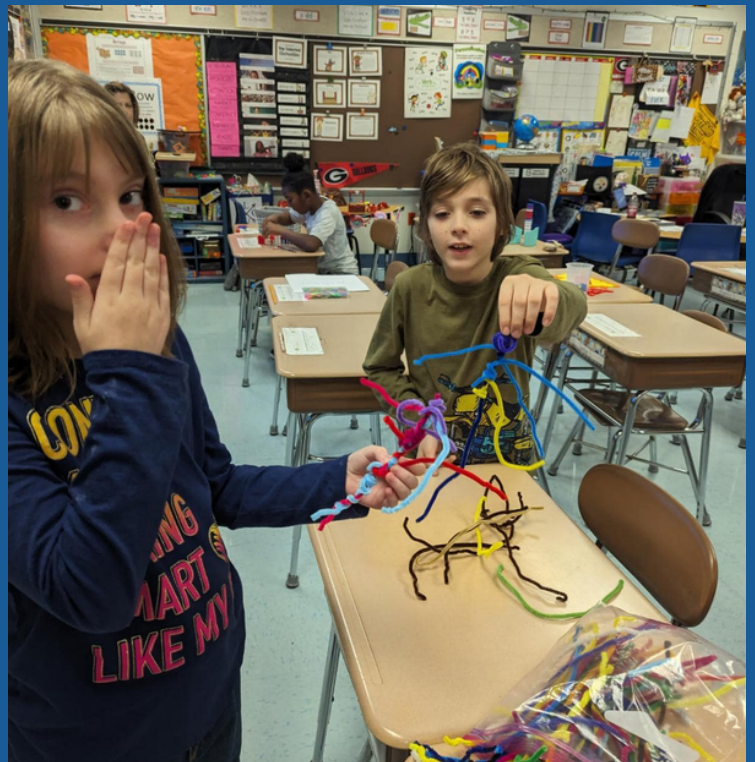


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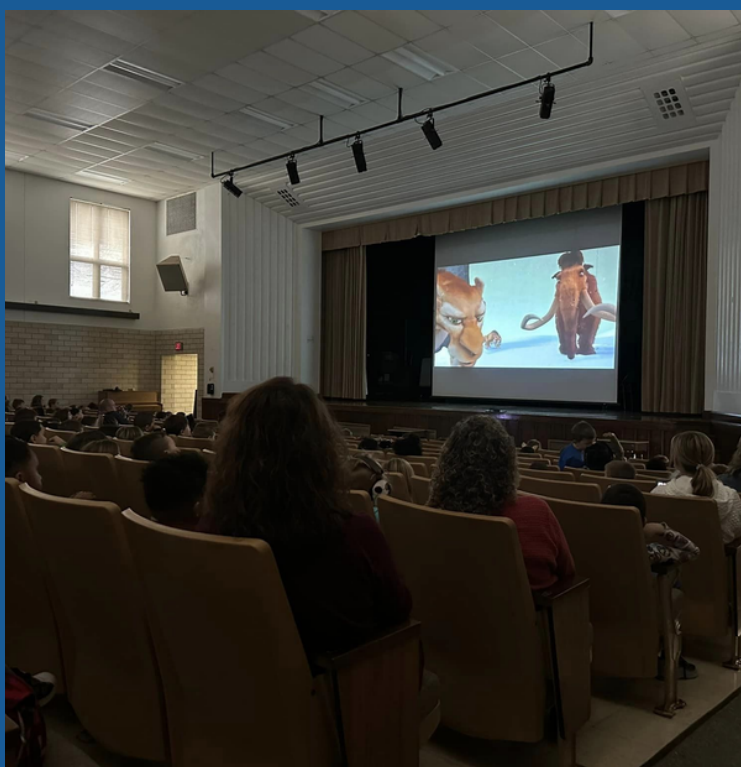
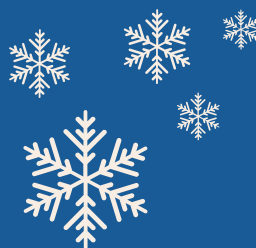


HAPPY 100TH DAY OF SCHOOL

Children's Institute Assembly

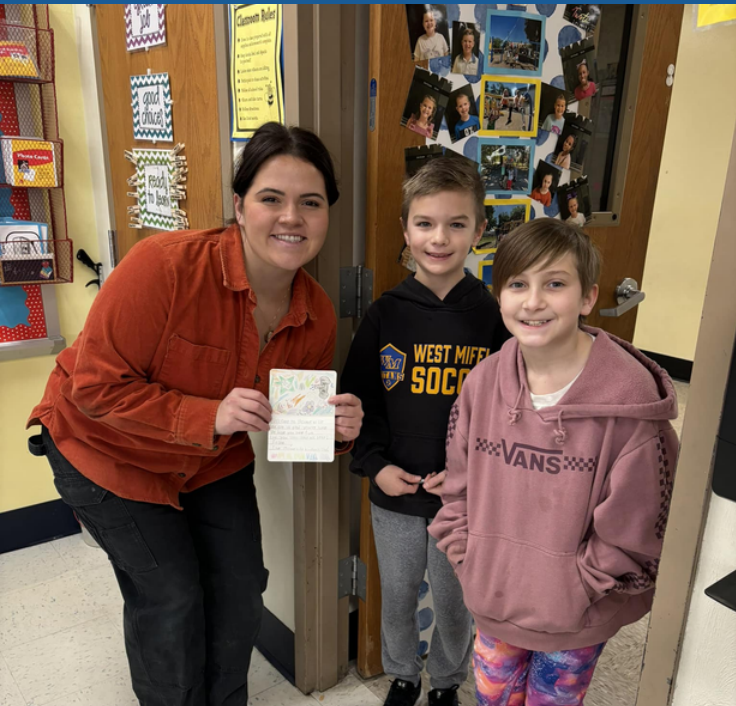


The Children's Institute came to Homeville today. Students learned about learning disabilities, bullying and cerebral palsy. Thank you to the PTA for providing this quality assembly.

Spring Math is a math intervention that is utilized for 20 minutes daily. Student scores are entered weekly, and the class-wide intervention is determined. Mrs. Rader's class is making fantastic progress! Her class has 100% intervention consistency. The class is progressing at 2.1 weeks per skill with 79% growth.
