Dear Mr. Angelaccio,

This letter is sent based on your request for notification or you are a school district representative. The Arlington Heights Park District may be applying a turf herbicide for the control of broadleaf weeds throughout the District. When parks have been inspected for weed population, and all other options for weed control have been considered, a herbicide may be used, and always at the lowest effective rate for the targeted weeds. Due to a number of weather conditions when applying weed control, we are not able to provide you with the exact date of the applications. However, all park areas will be posted 24 hours prior to the application, and will remain posted for 24 hours after completion. Postings will also be available on the Arlington Heights Park District web site (www.ahpd.org). As part of a green initiative, Greenbrier Park has been designated as a pesticide and herbicide free park.

We will also be applying a granular fertilizer to our athletic field areas periodically throughout the year by our commercial contractor, Harrell's Inc. This is a dry fertilizer product and contains no weed control. Fields will be marked with flags, and **can be used** immediately, once the application is completed. All applications will take place early in the morning starting at 5:00 am, and will conclude before any school functions may take place.

June 8, 2026 – 33-0-10 Fertilizer w/.067% Acelepryn
October 12, 2026 – 25-0-15 Fertilizer
