Dear Principal/Guidance Counselor:

Father John S. Hannon Council 5297, Knights of Columbus, Circleville, solicits your nomination(s) for the Annual James T. Shea Memorial Award.

In 2023, a grandson of Mr. Shea moved back to his hometown of Circleville. Shortly after his return, he inquired about the scholarship honoring his grandfather with a few members of The Knights of Columbus. We have learned from his grandson, that Mr. James T. Shea, was a Circleville resident and a better-than-average student-athlete at Circleville High School. He was a veteran of both World Wars, a sharpshooter in WW1 and an accountant in WW2. Mr. Shea was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council #5297, and his Catholic faith was especially important to him. Mr. Shea died in 1963.

This scholarship is a memorial to honor the legacy of Mr. James T. Shea. Keeping this in mind, Mr. Shea's family had asked that the Knights of Columbus slightly alter our awarding requirements in a manner which more closely align with those values that Mr. Shea held dear.

- 1. The first of the changes reflects the importance of faith in the student-athlete's life. Therefore, the committee now requests a letter of recommendation from the Pastor or Youth Minister, which affirms the faith-life of the student.
- 2. Second, the family's intent is to try and provide financial assistance to a student-athlete with need for assistance. Therefore, each student will need to furnish a copy of their FAFSA Student Aid Report as part of the application.
- 3. Finally, as mentioned Jim Shea was a sharpshooter in WW1, and he continued to hone his marksmanship skills throughout his life. Marksmanship was something he enjoyed and valued, in keeping with Jim's ideals, students who participate in competitive shooting sports will be given additional consideration.

The Shea Award honors a Senior scholar-athlete and now carries a \$500.00 scholarship renewable for four years. In addition to the three points mentioned above, the recipient must also be a senior Honor Roll Student and have earned at least one varsity letter.
