Dear High School Senior:

Attached is the application for the Ohio JCI Senate Charitable and Education Foundation Scholarship Program. The Ohio JCI Senate C & E Foundation is made up of the life members of the Ohio JCI Senate who were members of the U.S. Junior Chamber of Commerce (Jaycees).

You have three (3) categories of scholarships to choose from:

CATEGORY 1 - Academic-Based

CATEGORY 2 - Need-Based

CATEGORY 3 - Vocational

In the **Academic-Based** category, the **top two (2)** students selected will each receive a \$1000.00 scholarship grant. In addition, the top two (2) recipients' applications from this category will be submitted to the US JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Program. Scholarship grants at the national level will be awarded in amounts of \$1,500 or \$2000 to 50 graduating high school seniors in the United States attending a United States accredited college or university.

In the **Need-Based** category, there will be **at least two (2)** students selected with each receiving a \$1,000.00 scholarship grant. One (1) of these is a designated scholarship grant which will be given to a student who is a resident in one of the following counties: Allen, Putnam or Van Wert.

In the **Vocational** category, the top student selected will receive a \$1,000 grant. The top application from this category will be submitted to the US JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Program. Ten (10) students selected at the national level will each be awarded \$1000.00 scholarship grants to further their education by attending any United States' vocational, technical or trade school.

Students may only submit an application in one (1) category. Please select the category in which you wish to have your application judged and attach the enclosed page to the top of your application.

The deadline for submitting applications is January 12, 2026. Judging will take place January 31, 2026. **Only the winners** will be notified by letter. Please do not contact the national director as they will not know the outcome for the state. **No electronic submission will be accepted.**

Scholarship Application

Eligibility:

- Graduating high school seniors in Ohio for state scholarships and in the United States for national scholarships.
- STUDENTS MUST HAVE A GPA OF 3.25 AND ABOVE TO BE CONSIDERED.
- You must be a U.S. citizen to apply for this scholarship.

This package contains information and directions to apply for the Ohio/United States JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Program. The Vocational/Technical/Trade Scholarship is for students who plan to attend a vocational school, trade school, technical school, 2-year community college, or other short-term program. Fields of study may include, but are not limited to: automotive technology, plumbing, carpentry, welding, advanced manufacturing, cosmetology, computer repair, HVAC tech, medical assistant, LPN, culinary, powerline technology, paramedic, vet tech, pharmacy tech, legal assistant, etc. Checks will be made out in the name of the recipient and will be paid directly to the chosen Vocational/Technical/Trade Scholarship.

Instructions for the Ohio/US JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Application

A. The application must be typed in black ink. Print using single-sided sheets of paper. No duplex.

B. ON EACH PAGE OF THE APPLICATION PACKAGE, NEATLY HAND PRINT YOUR NAME AND THE PAGE NUMBER (in ink) AT THE TOP RIGHT CORNER.

Begin with the checklist as page 1, the photo page is 2, then continue to number the application and all attachments in the correct order. If reference letters or transcripts are submitted in sealed envelopes, number the envelopes for proper placement and the chairman will insert them. Staple all pages together in the upper left corner.

- **C.** Each student must have an active, working e-mail address listed.
- **D.** All materials **MUST** be submitted in one mailing. Materials sent in multiple mailings **WILL NOT** be accepted.
- **E**. Your application will be evaluated by individuals outside of your area. **Do not use acronyms** for clubs, events, awards, etc. If the name is not self explanatory, include a description. Examples: REACH should include a description such as: Oak City REACH Program to feed the homeless, or J. Smith Award for Top Female Tennis Player.

F. NO ELECTRONIC SUBMISSIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED AND MAILED BY JANUARY 12, 2026

- **G.** Included in this application package are all the necessary forms and instructions regarding additional information required. Please read all details in each section carefully- following them will give you the most points during the judging process!
