- **Graduation requirement of community service hours.** The community service log [form](#) is available in the offices at CHS and from Mrs. Meadows at LCJVS as well as on the website. The **20-21 school year required hours prior to graduation** are seniors-15; juniors-20, sophomores-20, freshmen-20. Students should attempt to complete 5 hours per school year. Hours completed over the summer are eligible for use as required hours for graduation.
