COLUMBIA:

• Mandatory graduation practice is Wednesday, May 19 beginning at 11 am at the stadium. After practice is complete, seniors are encouraged to travel to the K-8 building for a clapout from our young Raiders and the staff. - Graduation tickets are now available for pick up in the main office. Six tickets per graduate are allocated for the homeside stands. Additional well wishers may sit socially distanced in the visitor side fans, in their own chairs outside the stands or stand along the fence. Tickets will be punched at the gate and collected when entering the stands. Families are asked to sit together in pods at the stadium.
- If we have to go to a rain date, the **times** are changed as follows per email from Mr. Lynch, Saturday, May 22, ceremony at 1:00 pm. Sunday, May 23, ceremony at 1:00 pm.
- Seniors may pick up their cap and gown and announcements in the main office at CHS. All orders must be paid in full. Cash only is accepted at CHS, you may pay online with a credit card on jostens.com. Bring proof of payment if you are paying online.
- All fees, fines, lunch charges and the return of any CLSD property must be taken care of before diplomas will be released. Please make sure all debts are paid asap.
- **Graduation requirement** of **community service hours**. The community service log form is available in the offices at CHS and from Mrs. Meadows at LCJVS as well as on the website. Turn in log forms to Mrs. Hechko as they are completed. All students are required to complete this graduation requirement. Contact the guidance office if you have any questions. The **20-21 school year <u>required hours prior to graduation</u>** are seniors-15; juniors-20, sophomores-20, freshmen-20. Students should attempt to complete 5 hours per school year. <u>Hours completed over the summer are eligible for use as required hours for graduation</u>.
- Seniors may pick up their cap and gown and announcements in the main office at CHS. All orders must be paid in full. Cash only is accepted at CHS, you may pay online with a credit card on jostens.com. Bring proof of payment if you are paying online.
- Commencement Update: The ceremony is scheduled to be held at Southwest General Stadium at CHS on Friday, May 21 at 7:00 pm. There are rain dates assigned. Each graduate will receive a set number of tickets to be distributed to their families.

ELYRIA:

- The City of Elyria Parks & Recreation Department is currently accepting applications for the positions of lifeguard and swim instructor. - Attention Juniors: REQUIRED 12th Grade Meningococcal Vaccine: Ohio requires that current juniors will need Meningococcal booster prior to the start of their senior year. This booster is given anytime at age 16 and after. I want to give you time to get this done before September 2021 and turned into the school nurse. You can use the form that was emailed to your guardians or any form provided by a health professional. You are welcome to turn it in to EHS school nurse, team secretary or take a picture of the completed form but MUST be in an <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/juniors.2011/juniors.
- **ASVAB Testing:** On Wednesday, May 19th, the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) will be given by the U.S. government representatives in the Band Room from 7:50 AM until 11:12 AM. The ASVAB tests are designed to measure aptitudes in four domains: Verbal, Math, Science and Technical, and Spatial. Scores are good for two years and can be used for entrance into the military or as information for your use on deciding on career paths, vocational training or post-secondary education. If you are a sophomore, junior or senior wishing to take this test then see Lieutenant Colonel Jenkins in room 102W to reserve a seat and to get preparation materials or send email JenkinsRoy@elyriaschools.org and he will get it to you in your pod.
