# October is Manufacturing Month in the State of Ohio. Each day in October we will be sharing a MANU-FACT with you about manufacturing locally, regionally or nationally! We hope you find them interesting.

**There are 12.82 million manufacturing workers in the United States, accounting for 8.5 percent of the workforce.** Since the end of the Great Recession, manufacturers have hired an additional 1.37 million workers. There are 8.05 million and 4.77 million workers in durable and nondurable goods manufacturing, respectively.

Ohio manufacturing is a leader in US manufacturing jobs. In 2018, Ohio again ranked third in manufacturing employment national, and had 5.5% of all US Manufacturing jobs. According to this source, Ohio had 6,800 more manufacturing employees in 2018 than in 2017.
