October is Manufacturing Month in the State of Ohio. Each day in October we will be sharing a MANU-FACT with you about manufacturing locally, regionally or nationally! We hope you find them interesting.

Manufacturers have one of the highest percentages of workers who are eligible for health benefits provided by their employer. 92 percent of manufacturing employees were eligible for health insurance benefits in 2018, according to the Kaiser Family Foundation. This is significantly higher than the 79 percent average for all firms. Of those who are eligible, 82 percent participate in their employer's plans. There are only three other sectors—state and local government (85 percent), trade, communications and utilities (85 percent) and wholesale (84 percent)—that have higher participation rates.
