Over the next decade, 4.6 million manufacturing jobs will likely be needed, and 2.4 million are expected to go unfilled due to the skills gap. According to a recent report, the lack of qualified talent could take a significant bite out of economic growth, potentially costing as much as \$454 billion from manufacturing GDP in 2028 alone. Between now and 2028, a persistent skills shortage could cost \$2.5 trillion in reduced output.

All 10th and 11th graders who are thinking about attending college are encouraged to register.
