October is Manufacturing Month in the State of Ohio. Each day in October we will be sharing a MANUFACT with you about manufacturing locally, regionally or nationally! We hope you find them interesting.

Manufactured goods exports have grown substantially to our largest trading partners since 1990, including to Canada, Mexico and even China. The North American market remains vital for manufacturers in the United States. Canada and Mexico purchase more manufactured goods from the U.S. (\$500.3 billion in 2018) than from our next 11 largest trading partners combined (\$496.5 billion in 2018). Meanwhile, U.S.-manufactured goods exports to China have tripled from \$31.9 billion in 2005 to \$98.2 billion in 2018.
