Other repairs/replacements vary based on prices from Apple; this includes things like broken charging or headphone ports.

A few general recommendations:

- 1. Sit down as a family and make decisions about iPad rules in your household. Talk to your child about values and standards that you expect regarding all forms of media just as you would television, movies, music, and cell phone use. Make a family plan to keep the iPad safe at home. ex. Where will it be charged away from access to younger siblings, pets, etc. What hours can it be used at home? Common Sense Media has many suggestions for families: https://www.commonsensemedia.org
- 2. Students will be expected to return the same cord and charger in May or upon checkout from school. Please make other members of the household aware that this is a school charger, and it must be returned or a \$38.00 replacement charge.
- 3. MCSD iPads are a learning tool, much like a textbook, it is not a personal device. Bring your iPad to school each day charged, updated, and in working condition. (We recommend leaving your assigned charger at home; consider bringing an alternative/less expensive charger to school for emergencies.) Content/Activities should be school appropriate and within our code of conduct. Students should recognize and guard their personal and private information while online. While on the Internet, students shall not reveal personal information or communicate with strangers. Gaming is not allowed on school devices, especially during the school day, where it eats bandwidth and slows networks.
- 4. Cyberbullying or violence should be reported to administration, Montrose Police, and/or Safe to Tell.
- 5. Never leave your iPad unattended. Students may request a locker in the main office if they plan to leave campus and need a safe place to lock up their belongings and iPad. Never leave your iPad unattended at City Market or nearby restaurants; if it is lost or stolen, you will be responsible for the replacement fees.
- 6. Never leave your iPad in plain sight or in an unlocked vehicle. Break-ins/theft are common. Never leave your iPad in a vehicle overnight, especially during cold weather. Freezing temperatures are bad for battery, device life, and screens will shatter.
- 7. Finally, if your device is lost or misplaced during the school day, report it to the IT department in the library ASAP. If your device is stolen on campus, you will also report it to our campus police officer. If your device is stolen off campus, file a report with the Montrose Police Department.
